

Bursary, Scholarship and Temporary Funding Terms & Conditions Agreement

Bursaries, Scholarships and Temporary Funding Support are offered on the understanding that parents and pupils abide by the **School's Terms and Conditions**, which are downloadable from the CHS website.

The following conditions also apply.

Parents' Responsibility to the School

Bursaries, Scholarships and any Temporary Financial Support for parents are drawn from the fees provided by the great majority of parents and from families and CHS Alumni supporting the CHS Bursary Fund. There is therefore a duty by any parent in receipt of this funding to demonstrate respect and support for the School and its Parents. While it is the right of any parent to communicate their comments and concerns directly to the school, any action by a parent that fails to "uphold and promote the good name of the school", particularly using social media or similar methods to make critical or damaging remarks about the school, any of its employees and any persons associated with the school's educational provision may result in the immediate withdrawal of all funding provided.

"Parents are expected to give their support and encouragement to the aims of the school and to uphold and promote its good name; to continue the pupil's education at home and to ensure that the pupil maintains appropriate standards of punctuality, behaviour, diligence, discipline and dress."

Parents' Financial Commitment

The school offers some flexibility about payment of the school fee contribution from parents, normally arranged as an agreed fixed sum paid per calendar month. Failure to maintain payments in accordance with the arrangement agreed between the school and the parents could jeopardise the Bursary funding so parents should contact the school immediately if there are problems with meeting their financial commitments.

Parents' Commitment to their Child and to the School

Parents should make every effort to support their child in school and to support the school in the education of their child.

Unless otherwise agreed and confirmed by the School, any Temporary Financial Support is offered on the understanding that parents fully intend their child to remain

at the school until Form Six unless there are reasonable reasons agreed (such as moving from Central London or a serious change in family circumstances) with the school for the pupil to be withdrawn.

Funding will continue for the agreed term subject to:

The pupil maintaining a satisfactory punctuality and attendance record.

The pupil maintaining satisfactory academic progress.

The pupil maintaining a satisfactory behaviour record, both in and out of the school.

The pupil's active commitment to school activities and events.

Parents' Responsibility to the School conditions being followed.

Parents attending parent meetings and events*

Annual review of family's financial circumstances.
