

Viewing a Student's Grades and Assignments

In the parent view of Schoology, parents may choose to view their child's grades and assignments. Viewing grades and assignments from the parent view will allow you to see a complete list of assignments for each course, as well as determine if your child is missing assignments. To understand how to view grades and assignments, please watch the tutorials from FCPS linked below.

Option 1: Email Digest

- The email digest is an emailed report to parents about their children's Schoology activity, including grades, missing assignments, etc. Parents decide the frequency of the emails (daily or weekly).

Option 2: Viewing Grades in Each Course

- Looking up grades at the course level shows a breakdown of assignments and the scores of the assignments. From here, parents may also click on a child's assignment to see the child's work, including how long they worked on it.

Please note the following when viewing grades for your child:

- Due to the syncing of Schoology with our gradebook program, you must check each course to view grades and assignments for that subject.
- FCPS does not display overall term grades at the elementary school level. Parents and students will not see this option in gradebooks in Schoology.
- Parents will not be able to view or access Google Drive assignments, such as Google Slides and Google Docs, due to the sharing settings in Google.
