How to Participate

1. **Participant Cap:** 16
2. **Invite only** for “Eligible Players” as defined below.
3. **Become an Eligible Player by achieving at least one of the following:**
 - a. Becoming **ranked within the top 20** in the [OBBC “Beyblade X \(B4 Rules 2024\)” leaderboard](#) by August 26, 2024, the end of the Ranking Eligibility Period.
 - b. Earning a **1st place finish** in a [“Qualifying Event”](#).
 - i. If a player who previously won a Qualifying Event wins additional events, the 2nd place finisher will be granted the right to participate instead.
4. **Registration:**
 - a. An announcement will be posted in the OBBC Discord around the end of August and start of September asking Eligible Players to contact Blader Kei to confirm their registration.
 - b. Registration will be first-come, first-served among Eligible Players.

d. Companion Limitations:

- i. Due to space limitations or local by-laws, companions not participating in the tournament may not be permitted to enter the tournament venue. If too many participants bring a companion, the organizer reserves the right to ask for companions to leave the tournament venue. If your companion needs to be with you due to your age or due to medical reasons, please notify the organizer ahead of time and we will do our best to ensure your companion can enter the room.

e. Entry Fee eTransfer Payment Required:

- i. Paying the entry fee by eTransfer is required to secure a spot (read sending instructions below). If the event is canceled, the entry fee will be returned to you by eTransfer. The entry fee covers costs for the venue, prizes, and supplies.

f. Day-Of Registration:

- i. Registration on the day of the event for Eligible Players who don't confirm a spot beforehand will only be possible if spots are still available on a first-come, first-served basis.

5. Late Arrivals:

- a. Registered participants who arrive late may receive losses for unplayed, scheduled matches or may be replaced by another participant who is present and able to play.

6. Early Departure:

- a. Participants who leave early will receive losses for unplayed, scheduled matches.

Seeding Method

1. Eligible Players from Qualifying Events

- a. Eligible Players from Qualifying Events will be ordered amongst each other based on their Ranking. They will be positioned above all Eligible Players from Rankings.
- b. The Eligible Player from BEYBLADE X-TREME BATTLE Toronto Vol. 6 will be seeded below all other Eligible Players from Qualifying Events, but above all Eligible Players from Rankings.

2. Eligible Players from Rankings

- a. Eligible Players from Rankings will be ordered amongst each other based on their Ranking.

Equipment

3. Equipment:
 - a. **First Stage:**
 - i. At least **1 Beyblade X top**
 - b. **Final Stage:**
 - i. At least **3 Beyblade X tops** with no repeating parts
 - c. Up to **2 Launchers**
 - d. **3on3 Deck Box** or other concealment method which enables ordering
4. All matches are played in the [Xtreme Stadium \(Takara Tomy\)](#)

Rules

5. The tournament will be played primarily using the [WBO X Format Rulebook](#).
6. **Match Types**
 - a. **First Stage:** 1on1 Match Type
 - b. **Final Stage:** 3on3 Match Type
7. **Additional & Modified Rules**
 - a. **Banned Parts & Equipment:** Usage of any Blades, Ratchets, Bits, Launchers, or other equipment from Beyblade X products released within 14 days or less from the tournament date is prohibited.
 - b. **Match Start:** A match is considered to have started when both players have arrived at the stadium.
 - c. **Side Selection:** Before Beyblade Selection begins, players must: Decide their position on the left or right side of the stadium by playing one round of rock-paper-scissors, if either player has a preference. The judge must ask this before Beyblade Selection begins.
 - d. **Beyblade Selection:** Players must select their 1 Beyblade (First Stage) or 3 Beyblades (Final Stage) without being seen by their opponent and notify the judge when they are ready. After both players have completed their selection, when asked by the judge, they must present them to their opponent. The judge will then check the Beyblades and Launchers for both players. After the judge completes the inspection for both players, the

judge will return the Beyblade(s) disassembled and Launchers to each player. If any Beyblade or piece of equipment is found to be unusable for any reason, the judge may award point(s) to the opponent upon consultation with the head judge. Then, both players may restart the selection process. Once the selected Beyblades and Launchers are approved, players must then assemble their Beyblade in front of the stadium within view of the judge and their opponent. The first battle will then begin.

- e. **Launch Area:** The Launch Area is the circular opening on top of the Stadium Cover.
- f. **Launching:** A battle begins when the call of "3-2-1 Go Shoot!" starts. Beyblades must completely pass through the Launch Area after being launched. Beyblades are considered to have entered the Play Area once they have completely passed through the Launch Area. Beyblades must enter, return, or be in the Play Area in order to win a battle. If both Beyblades collide before either has touched the Stadium (a mid-air collision), the battle must be restarted. Bladers must launch their Beyblade from within a 20cm distance from the Stadium Base for the duration of their launch. The judge may award 1 point to the opponent of Bladers who miss shooting inside the Launch Area each time it happens after the first time.
- g. **Knocked-Out:** To begin being considered as a possible knock-out (Xtreme Finish or Over Finish), the entire Beyblade must enter the Xtreme Zone or Over Zone.
- h. **Burst Finish:** To be considered bursted (Burst Finish), any part of the Beyblade must be visibly detached (ex. Bit detaching from Ratchet, Ratchet and Bit detached from Blade, etc).
- i. **Tie Break Procedures:** The following tie break procedures will be used to determine finalists at the end of the First Stage among players with the same win/loss record. Block Round Robin: Wins vs. Tied Participants, Points Difference, Points Scored, and Tiebreak Match in that order.
- j. **4 Point Final Stage:** Final Stage Matches are played to 4 points for this Tournament.
- k. **Video Review:** Judges may review video replays to determine the result of a battle or match only for matches which take place in the Final Stage. A judge reserves the right to deny a player request for video review. Video

review may not be considered after the tournament has been marked as "ended" in Challenge.

- l. **Judge Decisions are Final:** Players have a right to respectfully question or ask for clarification on the reasoning for any call of a match they are playing in. If they disagree with the judge's call they are entitled to a second opinion and the Head Judge will be called to offer one. Decisions by the Head Judge are considered to be final. To ensure we can promptly progress through the tournament, any players who appear to unreasonably invoke and abuse this privilege over multiple battles or matches may be denied at the sole discretion of the match judge or Head Judge. Any match or battle result may not be changed once the tournament stage in question has been completed.
- m. **Part Breakage Inspection:** At the end of each battle during the 1st place and 3rd place matches, judges must inspect each Beyblade used in every battle for any breakages. If a Beyblade is found to have broken, the Breakage During Play procedure in the WBO X Format Rulebook must be followed.
- n. **Decorated Parts Prohibition:** Bladers may not use parts that have been decorated in the following ways for this Tournament: Parts that have been painted/clear-coated unofficially and parts that have been decorated with unofficial/homemade stickers.
- o. **Swapping Part Components/Disassembling Parts:** You may not use parts in your Beyblade which have been disassembled or had components swapped between them in any way, for this Tournament.
- p. **Battle Limit and Consecutive Draws:** No limitation applies to the number of Battles per Match, or the number of Consecutive Draws allowed per Battle during this tournament.
- q. **Own Finish:** If a Beyblade is launched directly into an Over Zone or Xtreme Zone, it is considered to be knocked-out. If a Beyblade is knocked-out into an Over Zone or Xtreme Zone without making contact with the opposing Beyblade, it is considered an Over Finish or an Xtreme Finish respectively.

Registration Phase 2: Eligible Players from Rankings

1. Registration Phase 2 is open as of August 26 at 11:59PM EST.

a. Applications received before this will not be valid and will not be responded to.

2. You **must be an Eligible Player from the Rankings in order to register during Registration Phase 2.**

3. Important Restrictions:

a. In the case that registration for the event becomes full due to the registration of Eligible Players from Rankings, any Eligible Players from Qualifying Events who have not registered yet have earned the right to take priority over all Eligible Players from Rankings if they register by September 1st, 2024 at 11:59PM EST. This means that they may bump the lowest ranked player out from the tournament. If this happens, the Eligible Player from the Ranking will have their entry fee refunded. Eligible Players from Qualifying Events who fail to submit their registration application prior to the September 1st, 2024 deadline will lose their guaranteed spot in the tournament if the registration becomes full.

b. Please note that there are limited spots in this tournament. Spots will be granted to Eligible Players from Rankings based on a first-come, first-served policy. Being an Eligible Player from Rankings does not guarantee a spot to you by default.
