Eagan High School Trap Shooting League Lettering Policy

As of February 2023

Eagan High School, in conjunction with the Minnesota State High School Clay Target League (MSHSCTL), has developed a lettering program for shooting sports. The requirements set forth in this policy are meant to be an equivalent to other varsity lettering requirements for this EHS's sports.

OBJECTIVE OF THE PROGRAM

- 1. To offer high school athletic status to shooting sport student athletes.
- 2. To recognize the accomplishments and time commitment of shooting sport student athletes with a varsity letter award to those who meet the requirements as defined by the high school. Official high school athletic recognition can be important to college applicants.

LETTERING POLICY

For an athlete to letter, they must be in high school and meet <u>both</u> requirements:

- 1. A Minimum Participation Requirement
- 2. A Varsity Level Average Score Requirement.

MINIMUM PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENT

For all athletes, the athlete must do either of the following:

- Compete in all 5 weekly competitions (Practice and Reserve weeks do not count).
- **2.** Compete in a minimum of 4 weekly competitions **AND** compete in at least one of the two State Tournaments (Alexandria Tournament or High School State Tournament).
 - *Note: **ALL** team members are eligible to compete at the Alexandria State Tournament, but not necessarily all athletes can compete in the High School State Tournament.

AVERAGE VARSITY LEVEL SCORE REQUIREMENT

The athlete's season average must be a varsity level score (average of 19-25).

Scores shot during practice rounds do not count toward the average. Reserve week scores will only count toward a shooter's average if used during a competition week.

Athletes may only earn one letter per school year in either the Fall or Spring season.
