How to import With Good Reason into your Canvas course site

- Download the With Good Reason ebook+ here (this is a "Common cartridge 1.x package" file)
 - a. Please note: your browser won't be able to preview this file.
- 2. Go to "Settings" in your Canvas course site
- 3. Select "Import course content"
- 4. From the "Content type" menu, select "Common cartridge 1.x package"
- 5. Source: choose the With Good Reason file linked in step 1
- 6. Default question bank: leave blank
- 7. Content: All content
- 8. Options: Leave both boxes blank
- 9. Do not convert Quizzes to New Quizzes

10. Click "Import"

Your course site should now have With Good Reason's modules, quizzes, and question banks.

To confirm that the upload succeeded:

- 1. Go to "Quizzes" in the course site into which you imported With Good Reason.
- 2. Click the three dots in the upper right-hand corner and select "Manage question banks."
- 3. Check that, for each Module, there are two question banks with 17 questions and one with 16.
- 4. Pick a random module quiz, like Module 2 Medium.
- 5. Select the "Show question details" box
- 6. Ensure that each question has content (generally an image of a map and a brief explanation) in the "General answer comments" box.
- 7. Repeat for another module or two.

Once you've confirmed that the import was successful, consider looking at the materials in the "For Instructors - Course Site Guide" Module.
