

2022-23 College Credit Plus (CCP)

~How to Participate~

Step 1 - WATCH CCP VIDEO

- Available on rvbears.org, click on “High School”, then under “Quick Links” choose “Guidance Department”, find “2022-23 CCP Informational Video” under Links

Step 2 - FILL OUT *CCP INTENT FORM* AND *MATURE CONTENT FORM* (NEW)

- Parent and student sign annually
- Turn both in to Guidance Office or email signed copy of each to:
- **DUE NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, APRIL 15, 2022**

Step 3 - ELIGIBILITY

- Cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.0 or higher, or
- Cumulative unweighted GPA of 2.75 and “A” or “B” in relevant high school courses, or
- Assessment scores (Accuplacer or ACT)
 - If attending RVHS for CCP classes, students can sign up for the Accuplacer test to qualify for CCP and to qualify for College Algebra course and/or Composition I course
 - See your School Counselor to sign up; Testing will be 3/15
- If planning to attend another college, contact CCP admissions of that college to ask about requirements

Step 4 - COLLEGE ADMISSION

- Students must apply for admission to the college they plan on taking courses from
 - If taking CCP at River View High School for the first time, must apply to Zane State College
 - Student & parent must sign CCP Zane State College Advising & Risk Acknowledgement forms that will be provided to the student with the college’s application for admission
- Must meet admission requirements of the college

Step 5 - COURSE REGISTRATION

- If the student is considered eligible and has been admitted to the college...
 - For CCP courses at River View, request the CCP course(s) you intend on taking next school year when you enter your requests in English class the week of March 7th
 - If intending on taking CCP course(s) not offered through RVHS, work with college CCP admissions staff to choose appropriate course(s)
 - Students must remember high school graduation requirements that they still need
 - Turn schedule into RVHS Guidance Office once finalized
 - Keep Guidance updated via email if any changes to CCP schedule are made
