

# Activity: Emoji Poetry

**How to complete this assignment:** If you were in class recently, you saw me demonstrate what emoji poetry is. Even if you weren't in class, the concept is simple:

pick any prompt of emojis;

write whatever creative thing comes to your mind based on what you see.

Basically, you translate the emojis into a poem. **Your poem doesn't have to rhyme.** Your poem **doesn't even have to be a "poem,"** per se.

**Just:** do it

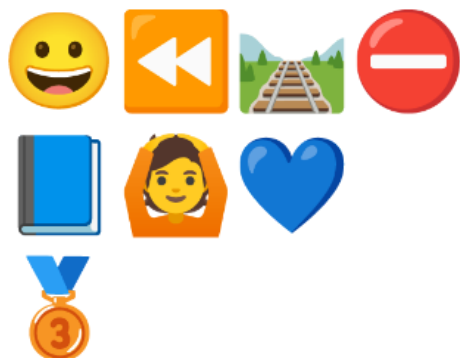
