PICTURE REGISTRATION

Dads will wear their concert shirt and Levi pants with tennis shoes.

TICKET REMINDERS AND POLICIES:

- Tickets are NOT included in the performance package
- All seating is reserved.
- Tickets purchased in advance online are \$12, Silver, \$14 Gold, \$16 Premium plus handling fees.
- Tickets purchased the day of the recital will be \$16 at the door for any available seats.
- No one ages 3 and older is admitted to the show without a ticket. Infants and children who may have a hard time remaining seated during the entire performance should not attend.
- Doors will remain closed until 30 minutes before showtimes.

CONCERT DIGITAL RECORDING

A digital recording of this year's concert has been included in your package. You will be receiving your digital download via email. We will NOT be held accountable for email addresses that are NOT up to date. To update info PLEASE email us or log onto your account and update!

DROP OFF:

Arrival time is when you are expected to be at the check-in table in full costume, hair, and makeup. Follow the signs for dancer drop-off. Preschool-aged students must be signed in and out by the same parent/guardian. Parents without a "volunteer" badge are not allowed past the drop-off point. This is to keep backstage less crowded and more organized. We will have plenty of supervision backstage.

- Diaper Dancer, Tiny Tots, Dads, Company: Inside the building at the south end of the foyer
- Academic and Academy: Outside the building, on the west side just south of the auditorium

WHAT TO PACK:

- Come with your 1st costume on
- Pack all your competition costumes in the order you perform in your hang bag
- We recommend sending a list for your dancer, so they know what order to change into their costumes.
- Awards ceremonies: wear a nice dress, don't forget your shoes
- Dad Dance: Concert shirt and any black bottoms (leggings, shorts, bikers)
- \$5-10 gift for your dance sister

Dad Dancers: *will be performing in the Company Showcase.* We will be holding a stage rehearsal for dads and daughters at approx. 5:15 pm on Friday, June 5. Following the rehearsal, dancers will line up for the show and dads will watch the show from the audience. Plan to head backstage after routine #33.

PICK UP: Following the show, all dancers will head back to the dressing room where ONE parent can come and pick them up.

SATURDAY, JUNE 6 | PERFORMANCE DAY

Where: Olympus High School, 4055 S 2300 E Holladay, UT

Please look carefully at your lineup so you know what shows your dancers are in and what routines they are performing. All teams will perform in the opener as well as one of their competition routines.

WHAT TO PACK:

Come with your opener costume on. BRING your hang bag with your additional costume and your concert

t-shirt and black bottoms (leggings, shorts, bikers)! All costumes, hair accessories, tights, and shoes should come in this bag! Please nothing extra.

PICK UP:

Please do not attempt to pick up your child during the performance. Wait until the end of the show. All students will be under the supervision of responsible adults and will be safe for the length of the performance. **Everyone** will be checked out through the dancer checkout by class. Please only send ONE guardian to the pick-up hallway.

ADDITIONAL SHOWS:

Collective is performing in all 3 shows. Please pack healthy non-messy snacks and a lunch on Saturday. Please make sure your dancer has water ONLY in the dressing room.

VOLUNTEERS:

Company parents do not need to purchase concert tickets for Saturday shows. Each company family will receive a volunteer slot that weekend, many will be while your dancer is already there to perform on Saturday. If you have a dancer or sibling in the development program, you will not have a volunteer assignment on Saturday so you can purchase tickets to watch them perform from the audience.

HAIR, MAKE-UP & COSTUME DETAILS:

We will wear the same hair and make-up as we did for the competition season.

BALLET PRODUCTION COSTUME DETAILS:

Mini Company (Quinn D & Genevieve B)

- Teal Class leo
- New pair of pink tights
- Clean ballet shoes

Teeny, Tiny, Junior Companies

- Simple solid black leotard (nothing on it no bows, skirts, rhinestones etc)
- New pair of pink tights
- Clean ballet shoes

Pre-Teen, Teen Companies

- Gray Lyrical costume (Teens also need a plain black Leo and black leggings)
- New pair of pink tights
- Clean Ballet Shoes

Petite Company, Collective, Lead Roles

- You will need to purchase a nude camisole leotard to wear underneath your rented ballet costume.
- New pair of pink tights
- Clean ballet shoes/poinette shoes

OPENER COSTUME DETAILS:

Get ready for an exciting start to our concert—our opener is going to be something really special! As the show begins, it will be “time to board the ship,” and our dancers will bring this vision to life by entering through the aisles of the auditorium, making their way to the stage as if they’re boarding together.

Dancers will be grouped into "families," each wearing coordinated attire to create a unified and visually fun look. We're excited to give a group leader in each group the opportunity to choose a theme for their "family," adding a creative and personal touch to the experience

Please review your group's theme and begin gathering the items. Wear your full opener outfit over your ballet attire to class on **Thursday, May 14th.**

5/13/26 Update: Our Opener costumes are looking fantastic and we are definitely headed in the right direction! We are so excited to see everything coming together and love the creativity and personality everyone is bringing to the stage.

We will be reaching out individually with a few personal adjustment details as needed. If your costume was not brought for pass off this past Thursday, it must be passed off on Monday or Tuesday.

A few important reminders as you finalize your look:

- If you are planning to wear a hat, your bun must be low and the hat must have a strap or secure way to stay attached to your head while performing.
- If you are wearing sunglasses, we highly recommend wearing them as a headband. They will need to be secured with bobby pins so they stay in place on stage.
- If you are wearing a dress, it needs to be calf length or shorter so you can comfortably dance and move on stage. All dresses also require biker shorts underneath.
- If you are wearing pajamas, please make sure you have a leo underneath.
- If you lift your arms and we can see skin, you need an additional layer underneath for coverage.
- If you are wearing shoes, they must be secured to your feet and safe to dance in. Barefoot is absolutely an option if preferred.
- All accessories must have your dancer's name on them. When dancers head backstage, accessories will be collected into buckets, so labeling everything will help us make sure items get returned to the correct owner.

Who needs tights on for opener:

- Teeny/Tiny: tan tights
- Mini: barre legs
- Petite: barre legs
- Juniors: tan tights
- Pre/Teen & Teen: tan tights
- Collective: barre legs
