Subject: Champion DC Statehood and Local Governance

Dear Mayor Bowser and Chair Mendelson:

We are writing as local Advisory Neighborhood Commissioners and other elected leaders — those who are closest to the people of DC and dedicated, unpaid public servants — to call on you to recommit to unequivocally and relentlessly supporting and advocating for DC Statehood and self-determination for the people of DC.

We are and represent the real DC: the neighbors, families, workers, students, seniors, native and new Washingtonians, and community members of all kinds who are the beating heart of a metropolis that is unique and separate from the federal city. For too long, Congress has denied DC residents full civic participation and self-determination, a decision rooted in racism that continues today. Recent local actions have undermined our local government's fulsome dedication to DC Statehood, opening the door to further Congressional interference and creating grave risk in our quest for self-determination.

While we may have diverging views on the issues that animate our local politics, our passion for local politics, good government and local government accountability, and DC Statehood is why we ran for local elected office. However deeply we feel about a particular issue — be it the height of developments in our community, the proper sentencing guidelines for criminal defendants, the ability to fund abortions, the disposition of public buildings, who can vote in local elections, or the regulation and taxation of cannabis — we agree that these decisions should be made through our robust local procedures by the Mayor of the District of Columbia and the DC Council, as well as the people of DC in exercising their voting rights.

All elected officials in DC must commit to the primary goal of local autonomy through DC Statehood, whether they are Advisory Neighborhood Commissioners, members of the DC Council or the DC State Board of Education, or Mayor of the District of Columbia. As the District of Columbia Democratic Party has <u>stated</u>, "It is time for all Democrats to join

with one voice to ... legislate our own laws." That commitment should involve fighting every effort to usurp local control and lobbying proactively against every budget rider, disapproval resolution, and Congressional act of interference — both those that are new and those that are already in existence — without limitation. That also includes fully funding DC Statehood efforts, supporting and helping to coordinate DC Statehood advocacy among various groups, and educating DC residents to be statehood advocates. Our right to self-determination demands nothing less.

The time has come for all of our elected leaders to rise to the moment and commit ourselves with renewed vigor in the fight for our rights as equal participants in our democracy. <u>Any equivocation</u> on this most important and fundamental quest for rights undermines our efforts for DC Statehood. Join us.
