ARTICLE TITLE

(Reflects the research conducted, maximum 15 words, Times New Roman 12 pt)

First Author's Name, Second Author's Name (Times New Roman 11 pt, Bold)

Affiliation (Study Program, Faculty, University/Institution) and Email Address

(Times New Roman 10 pt)

ABSTRACT

(Times New Roman 10 pt, Bold)

The abstract should contain the research problem, research objectives, research methods, and a summary of the findings. The abstract should consist of 150–200 words and be written in a single paragraph. The

abstract must be written in English.

(Times New Roman 10 pt)

Keywords: 2–3 keywords

INTRODUCTION (Times New Roman 12 pt, Bold)

The introduction should include:

1. The research problem;
2. Insights and proposed solutions to the problem;
3. The formulation of research objectives;
4. A summary of theoretical studies related to the research problem.

(Times New Roman 12 pt, 1 spacing)

METHOD (Times New Roman 12 pt, Bold)

The research method section should include:

1. Research design;
2. Population and sample;
3. Data collection techniques;
4. Data analysis techniques.

Avoid using subheadings in this section.

(Times New Roman 12 pt, 1 spacing)

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION (Times New Roman 12 pt, Bold)

This section should contain:

1. Answers to the research questions and problem statements;
2. Findings obtained during the research process;
3. Interpretation of the findings;
4. Discussion of the findings in relation to existing knowledge and theories.

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Tables

Place the table title above the table and provide a specific title.

(Table contents: Times New Roman 11 pt)

If the table is adapted from journals or books, the author's name and year of publication must be cited.

Figures

Figures should be in JPEG or PNG format, and their descriptions should be placed below the figures. Figure titles should also be placed below the figures/photos.

If the figure is the author's own work, include the author's name and the year the photo was taken. If the figure is adapted from journals or books, the author's name and year of publication must be cited. The source should be placed at the lower left corner below the figure/photo.

Presents a summary of the results and discussion in accordance with the research objectives.

Suggestions

Suggestions should be formulated based on the research findings that have been discussed.

REFERENCES (Times New Roman 12 pt, Bold)

The References using the APA Style, system contains the sources referred to in the manuscript. Referral sources used 80% in the form of primary sources such as scientific journals or research reports and is a library of the last 10 years with font times new roman, 12.
