

This is the motion that was passed unanimously by UFC on March 25, 2020.

Motion: Adopt the Proposal for Credit/Pass/No Credit Grading Option in Response to COVID-19 as outlined below. This motion will provide undergraduate students with the choice of designating any of their courses to receive a Credit/Pass/No Credit in place of a letter grade. Credit represents a C or higher letter grade; Pass represents a C-, D+, D; No Credit represents a failing grade. Credit or Pass can satisfy general education requirements. Departments and colleges can decide whether a student must receive credit or pass for specific major courses. Students will opt-in by submitting a request via email (to registrar@umw.edu) by the deadline (April 24, 2020).

In addition to the adoption of the Credit/Pass/No Credit policy, the UFC also endorses the actions taken by the Registrar for Spring 2020 to extend the deadline for student requests for course withdrawals and pass/fail designations to the last day of classes, April 24, 2020, and the action taken to lift the cap on the number of pass/fail designations that can be requested in one semester from one course to the number of courses being taken by the student.

- Students who elect to move to CRT/Pass/NC and end the course with a passing grade of C- or lower, may appeal to the Office of the Registrar to be switched to a letter grade retroactively. This would allow the student to receive credit with a PA, or with a D letter grade. Appeals will need to be emailed to the Office of the Registrar (registrar@umw.edu) by May 7, 2020.
