Objectives:

The purpose of teaching the discipline is to provide students with both theoretical knowledge in the field of project management, the tools used, development prospects and main trends, as well as practical skills related to the deployment of tools, structuring and task planning.

Achieving this goal involves solving the following tasks:

- ✓ Study of existing project management concepts;
- ✓ Study of the process approach and RUP;
- ✓ The acquisition of skills to deploy basic tools;
- ✓ The acquisition of skills in setting up processes in an organization related to software development.

Curriculum Outline:

Project management is a structured activity to achieve stated goals, aimed at meeting the real needs of people. The emergence of a project approach in the field of information technology brought a specific structuring of not only the activities of developers, but also affected the structuring of companies as a whole, planning tools, costing, development, testing, automation of product assembly, version control, and error tracking systems.

Contents:

There is a wide range of concepts based on the process approach. The basic structure of processes is RUP. Depending on the scale of the project and the specifics of the team, RUP modifications (Scrum, Agile, XP, Kanban) can be selected.

A separate component of project management is work with staff, staff recruitment, team motivation, the art of resolving conflict situations.
