Núcleo de Estudos Irlandeses at UFSC – NEI – is pleased to announce the inaugural Lady Gregory Grant for the *IX Jornada do Núcleo de Estudos Irlandeses da UFSC* – Soundscapes of Ireland, with the support of the Emigrant Support Programme of Ireland's Department of Foreign Affairs.

The purpose of the grant is to fund a postgraduate student (MA or PhD), or early career scholar (up to 5 years after conclusion of PhD), in the field of Irish Studies, to take part in *IX Jornada do Núcleo de Estudos Irlandeses da UFSC*, at Universidade Federal de Santa Catarina, from Sep 30th to Oct 1st, with a paper related to the theme of the event.

The grant is up to R\$2000,00 (up to two thousand reais), at the discretion of the organizing committee.
