GET TO KNOW THE MUSE

As a baby, Hisaki caught a virus that slowly deteriorated his hearing over time. When Hisaki was enrolled in primary school he wore hearing aids. Afraid that Hisaki would struggle with interacting with others, his parents registered Hisaki into a cram school for the deaf and hard of hearing. Through this he learned how to sign fluently with his parents studying beside him. As he became adjusted to the school, he felt understood by his peers and other adults which resonated deeply with him.

By the time Hisaki was ten, he completely lost his hearing. It was a turning point in his life where the protection of his parents felt smothering. The more they tried to shelter him, the more Hisaki felt like he had to rebel in order to regain the small amount of control he could have over himself. Losing his hearing was something he knew would happen at some point in his life. While he had already accepted this fact, his parents were trying to catch up over the loss. In order to give Hisaki more support, his parents brought in a hearing dog to help Hisaki through his daily life. With his new companion Jin at his side, Hisaki was quick to bond with him.

At an early age Hisaki had others refer to him with masculine pronouns as it felt right to him. By the time middle school had come around, he was openly using he/him pronouns. His parents were open minded to Hisaki's decision and took the time to use the right pronouns.

Meanwhile at school Hisaki could feel the adults losing trust in his capabilities for simple tasks, or treating him like a toddler. He couldn't describe the frustration he felt, but Hisaki knew that he was still just as capable as anyone else. He wanted to prove to others that he could be independent and it quickly manifested into a complex that Hisaki still carries with him.

The summer break before high school he had his cochlear implant surgery. It took him the whole break to adjust to the new sounds he heard and relearn how to hear. So during his first year, he sat in the front seat so he could hear the teacher clearly. He had difficulties remembering voices, but now as a second year, his hearing and understanding has improved a lot since the surgery.

QUICK TIMELINE

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. Born healthy, but a few months later he caught a virus that damaged his hearing over time.
2. At the age of 2 his wind magic manifested.
3. By the age of 4 he wore hearing aids and showed signs of wanting to be a boy.
4. Age 10 he lost all hearing and got a hearing dog.
5. In middle school he openly went by he/him pronouns
6. He attended a school festival held by Azarashi and met a senpai who inspired him to practice Kendo and attend the school.
7. The summer before high school (15) Hisaki had his cochlear implant surgery. It took him a month to relearn how to hear and another 5 months to fully understand how to listen to his surroundings.
8. Currently he is a second year student.

REASON FOR JOINING AZARASHI HIGH

In middle school he attended an Azarashi school festival and was inspired by the elegant and strong performance by the Kendo club. There was a senpai Hisaki talked to and encouraged Hisaki’s interest in Kendo regardless of his disability. Although kendo was a rough sport, it didn’t mean Hisaki couldn’t do it. Hisaki felt that someone saw potential in him and supported him to do something new. It was the small push Hisaki needed to pursue a budding interest.

By the time Hisaki enrolled as a first year, the charismatic senpai had already graduated, however he still carries their words close to heart.

MAGIC MANIFESTATION

The moment when Hisaki’s parents found his affinity for wind magic was when Hisaki still used a baby walker. The poor little guy sneezed out a (small) storm causing a mess in the living room. After this event, his parents had to find ways to secure pictures hanging from walls or velcro certain decor onto table tops. As well as figuring out some emergency baby stoppers on the walker, thankfully his mom is an engineer and his dad works from home as an architect to keep an eye on Hisaki. Through Hisaki’s unforeseen wind abilities, his parents have studied internal structures of homes and have made models to withstand strong storms both inside and outside.

He often uses it in his daily life such as drying his hair quicker or floating every now and then for fun. 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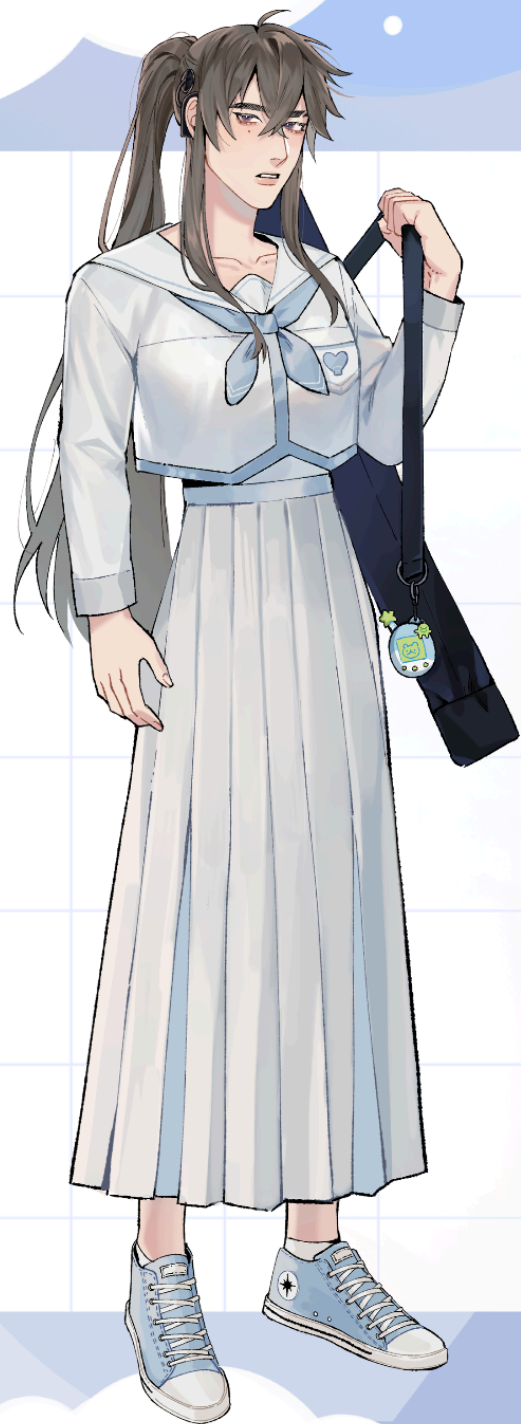
