- **RELATIONSHIPS:** Establish positive relationships with students and provide a positive classroom environment conducive to learning.

- **STUDENT SUPPORT:** Make sure all students get help as soon as it is needed.



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- **COMMUNICATION:** Provide ongoing communication of student progress through parent-teacher conferences, student progress reports, and other assessment tools provided at the school and district level.
- Maintain ongoing communication with parents by providing information about student progress through weekly updates of assignments, calendars, and *PowerTeacher*.

Parent/Guardian's Agreement
