Here is one of many examples that the quran shows of being ahead of science in its time.




It perfectly describes a process that without advanced technology would not be known to man-kind.

The messenger of Allah sought to show the people proof of his prophetship. The Holy Prophet (p.b.u.h.) pointed out his finger towards moon and it splitted up into two pieces. The Holy Qur'an mentions it as under: "The Hour {of Judgement} is drawing near, and the moon is cleft in two. Yet when they see a sign(the disbelievers)turn their backs and say: 'Strong magic!'" {Q. 54:1} However, the disbelievers rejected the event as magic.

The bible says his name

the term "muhammadim" in the Hebrew Bible's Song of Solomon 5:16 as a reference to the Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him). The word's resemblance to "Muhammad" and its meaning, "the praised one," suggests a subtle acknowledgment of the Prophet within the Hebrew scriptures. This reflects the universal message of monotheism and the continuity of prophethood throughout history, as Muslims believe in the recognition of Prophet Muhammad across various religious traditions.

some mathematical miracles of the quran

The word “Salawat” (prayers) is mentioned 5 times in the Quran, and the number of daily prayers mandatory for every Muslim is A- Subh, A-Duhr, Al-Asr, Al-Maghrib, Al-Isha. The word “Yawn” (day), in the singular, is mentioned 365 times in the Quran, just as the number of days there are in a year. The word “Ayyam” (days), in the plural, is mentioned 30 times in the Quran, just as the number of months there are in a month.

Symmetry of the quran

Th“al Hayat” (life) 145 times, “al Mawt” (death)145 times

“al-Dunya” (mundane life) 115 times, “al Ajira” (the afterlife) 115 times,

“Malaika” (angels) 88 times, “Shayatin” (demons) 88 times,

“ar Rajul (man) 24 times, “al Mar’a (woman) 24 times,

“ar Raghba (wish), 8 times “al Jauf (fear) 8 times,

“as Salihat (good deeds) 167 times, “as Sayya’at” (wrongdoings) 167 times,

“an Nafaa” (benefit) 50 times, “al Fasad (corruption) 50 times.

Another mathematical miracle of the quran

The numerical miracle in the Qur'an involves numerous numbers, of which 7 is the primary one. But why 7? It seems that this number shares a strong relationship with the way our universe was created and structured. The Earth has seven layers: the crust, lithosphere, upper mantle, asthenosphere, lower mantle, outer core and inner core. The atmosphere has 7 layers: the Troposphere, Stratosphere, Ozonosphere, Mesosphere, Thermosphere, Ionosphere and the Exosphere. Atoms, the basic building blocks of matter, have a seven-layered structure. The universe has 7 skies, and the one we see decorated with stars at night is only one of those 7.

God Almighty perhaps wanted to include this fascinating number not only in his creations, but in his Holy book. Now, I will attempt to explain some miracles of the number 7 in the Qur'an: • The number of verses in the Qur'an that referred to the seven skies is actually 7! • The word "the Hereafter" is mentioned 70 times in the Quran, a multiple of 7! • Hell-Fire has seven doors to it, and the number of times the word "Hell-Fire" ('Jahannam' in Arabic) is repeated in the Qur'an is 77, a multiple of 7!

The first time God Almighty (Allah) mentions the number 7 in the Qur'an was in Chapter 2, Verse 29 when he says: "It is He Who hath created for you all things that are on earth; then He turned to heaven and made them into seven firmaments; and of all things He hath perfect knowledge. (29)". The last time Allah mentions the number 7 is in Chapter 78, Verse 12 when he states: "And (have We not) built over you the seven firmaments, (12)". Now observe this:

The number of chapters between the first chapter that mentions this number and the last chapter that mentions it is 77, a multiple of 7! o Not only that, but amazingly, the number of verses between the first verse that mentions 7 and the last verse that mentions 7 is 5649, also a multiple of 7. o And even more amazingly, the number of verses that come from the beginning of Chapter 2 until the verse where 7 is first mentioned is the exact same number of verses as from the verse where 7 is last mentioned until the end of Chapter 78: 28 verses, which is also a multiple of 7!

o Furthermore, from the very beginning of Chapter 2, the chapter which first mentions number 7, to the very end of Chapter 78, the chapter which last mentions it, there are exactly 5705 verses, a multiple of 7! Check it yourself! o The number of verses that come before the first verse where 7 is mentioned is 35, which is a multiple of 7, and the number of verses that come before the verse where 7 is last mentioned is 5684, a multiple of 7! This is only a small ounce of the many examples of the wonders of number 7 in the Qur'an, let alone other prime numbers such as 13 and 19 and others. But the question remains to all those who question the Qur'an's authenticity: could have all this happened by coincidence? Can this infallible accuracy have been sheer luck, or is there a precise system of mathematics that no one could have ever dreamed of concocting, proving through the language of numbers that this book is completely and utterly the word of God?

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victory of the roman empire over the persians

The Pagan Quraish of Makkah {Makkah) rejoiced at the overthrow of Rome by Persia. They were pro-Persian, and in their heart they hoped that the nascent movement of islam, which at that time was, from a worldly point of view, very weak and helpless, signs of the times. They are told here that they would soon be disillusioned in both their calculations, and it actually so happened at the battle of ippus in 622 (the year ofHijrat) and in 624, when Heraclius carried his campaign into the heart of Persia and the Mak'kan (Mak'ka.hn) Quraish were beaten off at Badr. The Battle of Badr (2 A.H = 624 A.D.) was a real time of rejoicing for the Believers and a time of disillusionment for the arrogant Quraish, who thought that they could crush the whole movement of Islam in Madi.p.a as they had tried to do in Makkah (Makkah), but they were signally repulsed.The Holy Qur'an mentions this event as under: "Alif Lam mim. The Roman Empire has been defeated in a neighboring land. But after their defeat they shall themselves gain victory within a few years. Allah's is the command before and after. On that day believers will rejoice in Allah's help. He gives victory to whom He will. He is the Mighty one, the Merciful." (Q 30:1).

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Jesus is not the son nor is he god

The Prophet is Mentioned in Previous Revelations

"in Isaiah 29:12:

And the book is delivered to him that is not learned, saying, Read this, I pray thee: and he saith,
I am not learned.

We know the story when the Angel Gabriel came to Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) in the Cave of
Hira that he commanded Muhammad to "Read" and Muhammad replied that he could not read

or "I am not learned".

He (SAW) is found within hindu scriptures

In the Atharva Veda, it is mentioned that the praiseworthy among people shall be praised; it is known that the name Muhammad in Arabic actually means "the praiseworthy."

It also states that the promised prophet will be a camel rider, which is interesting because Indian prophets were forbidden to ride camels. Prophet Jesus, according to the New Testament, rode on an ass but not on a camel, but it is well known that Prophet Muhammad rode a camel.

The seventh mantra also speaks about someone who is going to be a guide to all people, and Prophet Muhammad always emphasized that he was not sent to a particular people, like Israelites alone or Arabs alone, but to the whole world.

The sixth mantra speaks about some of the brave people who vanquished without a battle and that the number of their opponents was 10,000, which could be a reference to the battle of the allies or the trench that took place during Prophet Muhammad's time. The number of the people who put a siege around Madinah were indeed 10,000, and they were vanquished without a battle because God sent a hurricane that finally, after a long siege, forced them to leave.

In the Rig Veda, it speaks about a person who is described as truthful and trustworthy, powerful and generous who will be famous with 10,000. All these are the characteristics of Prophet Muhammad, and the number 10,000 could be a possible reference to the number of the Companions of Prophet Muhammad who entered Makkah victoriously.

Islam Promotes the Use of Logic, Reason, and Knowledge

“(This is) a Book (the Quran) which We have sent down to you, full of blessings that they may ponder over its Verses, and that men of understanding may remember” [Saad 38:29].

Al-Qadi ‘Iyad said concerning the miraculous aspects of the Quran:

“In it you will see that there is an explanation of a set of divine laws; it mentions the way of proof based on reason, presents arguments against the misguided followers of different religions and sects, and argues against them on the basis of strong and clear proof, using very easy and concise language. Those who pretend to be clever tried to come up with proof and evidence like that, but they were not able to do so.” (Ash-Shifa (1/390))

The texts of the revelation do not contain anything that is impossible according to rational thinking or that would be rejected by reason, and the texts never presented an argument that contradicts reason or contradicts any analogy based on rational thinking. Rather the proponents of falsehood never presented any analogy to support their falsehood but the Quran refuted it on the basis of truth and an argument that is based on clear reason.

Allah, may He be exalted, says (interpretation of the meaning):

“And no example or similitude do they bring (to oppose or to find fault in you or in this Quran), but We reveal to you the truth (against that similitude or example), and the better explanation thereof” [al-Furqan 25:33].

Haman Mentioned by Name

Before explaining who Haman is and why his name and status is important, first we must have a brief understanding of what hieroglyphics are. Hieroglyphics were the ancient writing script of the Egyptians. Scientists believed it started in the 32 Century

BC (3,200 BC, aka 3,800 years before the Prophet). By the 5th century AD knowledge of hieroglyphic writing was lost, until the 1820s when it was deciphered using the Rosetta Stone. Haman is important because he is mentioned in the Quran as essentially being Pharaoh's architect or head of construction. The Quran says:

وَقَالَ فِرْعَوْنُ يَا أَيُّهَا الْمَلَأُ مَا عَلِمْتُ لَكُمْ مِنْ إِلَهٍ غَيْرِي فَأَوْقِدْ لِي يَا هَامَانُ عَلَى الطِّينِ فَاجْعَلْ لِي صَرْحًا لَعَلِّي أَطَّلِعُ إِلَى إِلَهِ مُوسَى وَإِنِّي لَأَظُنُّهُ مِنَ الْكَاذِبِينَ

And Pharaoh said, "O eminent ones, I have not known you to have a god other than me. Then ignite for me, O Haman, [a fire] upon the clay and make for me a tower that I may look at the God of Moses. And indeed, I do think he is among the liars."

Quran [28:38]none

Haman is being commanded by Pharaoh to build a tall tower. Prior to unlocking the hieroglyphics skeptics of the Quran, assuming the Prophet copied the Quran from the Bible, said this was a copying error because Haman was mentioned in the Bible as an assistant of a Persian King after the time of Moses, not head of construction of Pharaoh at the time of Moses. But with the deconstruction of the hieroglyphics Egyptologists found Haman working in Egypt as "overseer of the stone Masons." How could anyone 1400 hundred years ago, let alone an unlettered man, know this?

The Challenge to Produce One Like it

During the Prophet Muhammad PBUH time the Arabs were known for their Poetry. They would essentially have poetry battles, where they would compete to say the best lines of poetry. If you wanted people to listen to you or respect you, one way was to be a great poet.

When the Prophet PBUH made a claim to prophecy the Arabs did not like it. For most of his Prophetic life, the Prophet PBUH was seen as the enemy to the Arabs in general. They didn't like what he had to say because it meant changing most of their traditions, and their society. At first they ignored him, then they asked him to stop, they tried making deals with him, they bullied him, they killed his companions, they physical harmed him, tried to kill him, and went to war against him.

Essentially his Prophethood brought them great difficulty, but they were given a way of disproving the Prophet without resorting to violence. The Quran states:

قُلْ لِّئِنْ اجْتَمَعَتِ الْإِنْسُ وَالْجِنُّ عَلَى أَنْ يَأْتُوا بِمِثْلِ هَذَا الْقُرْآنِ لَا يَأْتُونَ بِمِثْلِهِ وَلَوْ كَانَ بَعْضُهُمْ لِبَعْضٍ ظَهِيرًا

Say, "If mankind and the jinn gathered in order to **produce the like of this Qur'an**, they could not produce the like of it, even if they were to each other assistants."

Quran [17:88]none

Then Allah made it simpler for them. Rather than producing a whole Quran, simply make **10 chapters** like it.

أَمْ يَقُولُونَ افْتَرَاهُ قُلْ فَأْتُوا بِعَشْرِ سُوْرٍ مِّثْلِهِ مُفْتَرِيَاتٍ وَادْعُوا مَنْ اسْتَطَعْتُمْ مِّنْ دُونِ اللَّهِ إِنْ كُنْتُمْ صَادِقِينَ

Or do they say, "He invented it"? Say, "Then **bring ten surahs [chapters]** like it that have been invented and call upon [for assistance] whomever you can besides Allah, if you should be truthful."

Quran [11:13]none

Then finally Allah makes the challenge **even simpler**, produce **1 chapter** like it. The shortest chapter in the Quran is only 3 sentences.

وَإِنْ كُنْتُمْ فِي رَيْبٍ مِّمَّا نَزَّلْنَا عَلَىٰ عَبْدِنَا فَأْتُوا بِسُوْرَةٍ مِّثْلِهِ وَادْعُوا شُهَدَاءَكُمْ مِّنْ دُونِ اللَّهِ إِنْ كُنْتُمْ صَادِقِينَ

And if you are in doubt about what We have sent down upon Our Servant

*[Muhammad], then **produce a surah** [chapter] the like thereof and call upon your witnesses other than Allah, if you should be truthful.*

Quran [2:23]none

The Arabs of that time were **not able to meet this challenge**, and until now **nobody has met this challenge**. There are many ways to look at the challenge. One way is the wording itself. Produce a Quran with similar wording and meaning, flow, and style.

Another is the content. The content which includes observational proofs, historical proofs, guidance, information about the unseen (angels, the day of judgment, God), logical proofs, and more.

Yet another is the impact of the Quran. Produce a book with the same impact of the Quran. A book that would lead people across the world of different backgrounds to memorize the text and base their lives upon it. A text that would result in **BILLIONS** of people accepting it as the word of God. So get your helpers and spend as much time as you need, to produce a book of similar effect.

Bedouin Arabs would compete in the building of tall buildings

This is the end of a long hadith, where the Messenger of Allah PBUH was questioned by a man no one knew.

He [the man] asked: "When will the Hour be?" He [the Prophet] said: 'The one who is being asked about it does not know more than the one who is asking.'
*He [the man] asked: 'Then what are its signs?' he [the prophet] said: 'When the slave woman gives birth to her mistress' 'and **when you see barefoot, naked, destitute shepherds competing in constructing tall buildings.**'*

sunan ibn majah graded sahih by Darussalaamnone

The barefooted Bedouins competing in building tall buildings. Today we find in the Arabian Peninsula, the Arabs who used to be impoverished herders of camels and sheep, are competing in building the tallest buildings. The tallest building in the world is the Burj Khalifa in the United Arab Emirates.

Abu Lahab never becoming a Muslim

There is a chapter in the Quran revealed early on in the Prophet's mission. In this chapter it states that Abu Lahab, a member of the Quraysh tribe living in Makkah where the Prophet started preaching Islam, would go to hell. Essentially for Abu Lahab to go to hell, from the Islamic perspective, would be for him to refuse Islam even after the clear proofs came to him. Abu Lahab did in fact die a disbeliever, and if he wished to disprove

Islam, all he had to do was become a Muslim. Yet he never did and thus this prophecy came true.

تَبَّتْ يَدَا أَبِي لَهَبٍ وَتَبَّ (١) مَا أَغْنَىٰ عَنْهُ مَالُهُ وَمَا كَسَبَ (٢) سَيَصْلَىٰ نَارًا ذَاتَ لَهَبٍ (٣) وَامْرَأَتُهُ حَمَّالَةَ الْحَطَبِ (٤) فِي جِيدِهَا حَبْلٌ مِّن مَّسَدٍ

May the hands of Abu Lahab be ruined, and ruined is he. (1) His wealth will not avail him or that which he gained. (2) He will [enter to] burn in a Fire of [blazing] flame (3) And his wife [as well] – the carrier of firewood. (4) Around her neck is a rope of [twisted] fiber. (5)

The widespread of usury/interest

The Prophet PBUH said:

“A time will come over the people when they will consume ribā [usury/interest].” They asked him, “All of them?” He said, “Whoever does not consume it will [still] be reached by its dust.”

Ahmadnone

This is pretty self explanatory and again another amazing prophecy. The whole world is indeed controlled by banks which are all involved in interest. How do we buy cars, houses, schooling and so on? It's all on interest. Car insurance, housing insurance, life insurance. All on interest. Only a select few of us avoid it directly, and an even smaller minority avoid it completely. The money itself is based on debt.

The Euphrates River is drying up to reveal Gold

It is a prophecy that the end times will not come until after the Euphrates River dries up and reveals gold, currently it is drying up and revealing some amounts of gold, that are in hill or mountain shaped humps.

John 16:14 "He will glorify Me."

The Quran brought by Muhammad glorifies Jesus:

"...who shall become known as the Christ Jesus, son of Mary, of great honor in this world and in the life to come, and [shall be] of those who are drawn near unto God."
(Quran 3:45)

Muhammad also glorified Jesus:

"Whoever testifies that none deserves worship except God, who has no partner, and that Muhammad is His servant and Messenger, and that Jesus is the servant of God, His Messenger, and His Word which He bestowed in Mary, and a spirit created from Him, and that Paradise is true, and that Hell is true, God will admit him into Paradise, according to his deeds." (Saheeh Al-Bukhari, Saheeh Muslim)

John 16:8 "he will convince the world of its sin, and of God's righteousness, and of the coming judgment."

The Quran announces:

"Indeed, they have disbelieved who say, 'God is the Christ, son of Mary' - seeing that the Christ [himself] said, 'O Children of Israel! Worship God [alone], who is my Lord as well as your Lord.' 'Indeed, whoever ascribes divinity to any being beside God, unto him will God deny paradise, and his goal shall be the fire: and there are not for the wrongdoers any helpers!'" (Quran 5:72)

John 16:13 "he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, [that] shall he speak."

The Quran says of Muhammad:

"Neither does he speak out of his own desire: that [which he conveys to you] is but [a divine] inspiration with which he is being inspired." (Quran 53:3-4)

John 14:26 "and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you."

The words of the Quran:

"...while the Messiah had said, 'O Children of Israel, worship God, my Lord and your Lord.'" (Quran 5:72)

...reminds people of the first and greatest command of Jesus they have forgotten:

"The first of all the commandments is, 'Hear, O Israel; the Lord our God is one Lord.'" (Mark 12:29)

John 16:13 "and He will disclose to you what is to come."

The Quran states:

"That is from the news of the unseen which We reveal, [O Muhammad], to you..."
(Quran 12:102)

Hudhaifa, a disciple of Prophet Muhammad, tells us:

"The Prophet once delivered a speech in front of us wherein he left nothing but mentioned everything that would happen till the Hour (of Judgment)." (Saheeh Al-Bukhari)

John 14:16 "that he may abide with you for ever."

...meaning his original teachings will remain forever. Muhammad was God's last prophet to humanity.[1] His teachings are perfectly preserved. He lives in the hearts and minds of his adoring followers who worship God in his exact imitation. No man, including Jesus or Muhammad, has an eternal life on earth. Parakletos is not an exception either. This cannot be an allusion to the Holy Ghost, for present day creed of the Holy Ghost did not exist until the Council of Chalcedon, in 451 CE, four and half centuries after Jesus.
