
## **Art Attribution on Twitch**



## **Emote Attribution** - How to Assign an Artist to an Emote:


Follow this procedure to credit an artist who made an emote for you. This will display their Twitch username on the emote details.




- 1. First, your artist needs to have **Allow attribution on Twitch** enabled. (If I, ShivaSenpai, am your artist then you can skip to step 2 as I already have this enabled.)
  - a. The artist can find Emote Attribution by clicking on their profile picture when logged into Twitch then select **Emote Attribution** from the menu.




- 2. Log into your Twitch account.
- 3. Click on your profile picture in the upper right > select **Creator Dashboard**.




4. In the column on the left, select Viewer Rewards > Emotes.



5. When you upload the emote, enter the artist's Twitch username into the **Emote**Attribution field.



6. Your artist will say **pending** for now. Once you upload the emote, a notification should be sent to your artist asking them to approve the emote attribution. Once the artist approves, they should now display when viewers click on your emotes.




## **Artist Badge - How to Assign the Artist Role:**


Follow this procedure to grant an artist the Artist Role on your channel. This will display an artist badge next to their name in your chat.



- 1. Log into your Twitch account.
- 2. Click on your profile picture in the upper right > select **Creator Dashboard**.




3. In the left column, select **Community** > **Roles Manager**.



4. Click the **Add New** button > type the artist's Twitch username into the **Search** box > select the artist.



5. Select the **Artist** role.



6. Now the artist icon should display by that artist's name on Twitch whenever they're in your chat like so:
