

KINGSLEY SPECTATOR POLICY



In order for play to occur, we must follow IDPH guidelines. Please see information below regarding Kingsley's IDPH Spectator Policy for all IHSA & IESA extra-curricular events.

While we are not going to be able to accommodate all spectators, or even entire families, we will provide an opportunity for all student-athletes to have representation in the crowd. At this time, due to spacing in our facility and IDPH Spectator Policies, each Kingsley's player will be allowed one (1) spectator per event (following the guidelines listed below). Please note children/siblings count as a spectator. We are not allowing spectators for the visiting team, which will allow us to maximize the number of Kingsley family members in attendance within our space.

Please note the following guidelines will be in place and are expected to be followed. Failure to adhere to these guidelines will result in an invitation to leave our facility.

Kingsley Spectator Guidelines

- ❖ MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES!
 - > Failure to follow IDPH guidelines will result in immediate removal of individuals.
- Spectators will check in at the table upon arrival.
 - ➤ We will be checking-in each spectator according to our team rosters for each grade level (7th, 8th).
 - The staff supervisor will check-in each spectator when he or she turns in their *COVID Certification Pass*. **No one** will be admitted to an event without this pass. Parents and/or guardians can ask their student athlete for these passes. Each player will be given **one pass** per game/match.
 - Please note on the COVID certification pass, spectators will need to self-certify, based on the recommendations made by the State of Illinois and the CDC.
 - This includes an individual taking their own temperature *before* coming to the event.
- Spectators will not be allowed into the game without the proper authorization.
 - Spectators should not expect entry until 15 minutes prior to scheduled start times. Please see each sport's calendar for the start time of their event. If a spectator is dropping off a player he/she must remain outside the building until this time.
 - Spectators will only be able to watch the game in which their child is participating due to restrictions. They must leave directly after the game/match.
- ❖ The gym will be cleared immediately at the conclusion of the game.
 - > Spectators for the first game should exit the gym and return to their vehicles. No one

is allowed to stand in the gyrm or hallway to wait for players, socialize, etc.

- > No gathering in the gym, or outside in the hall.
- > Gym spectators will enter through the front doors of the building and will exit the door at the end of the music hallway.
- > The bleachers/seating areas will be disinfected between games.
- Upon entry, please proceed to the designated seating area and sit on a marked space (represented by a sticker) that is socially distanced from other spectators. Members of the same household may sit together.
- Gym Doors will remain closed, except for 15 minutes initial entry and will be checked periodically throughout the game. Late arrivals are okay, but do not expect immediate entry.
- No Concessions will be available at this time. No Food or Drink allowed in Gyms.
- Restrooms are located
 - ➤ Off the main music/PE hallway. These will be the only open restrooms.
