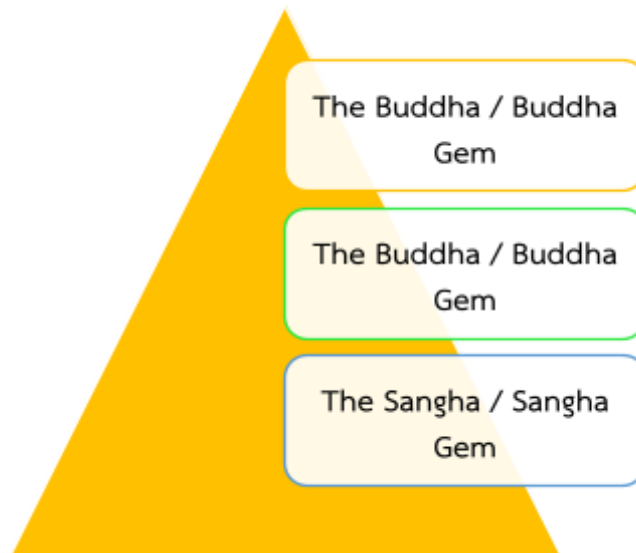


Figure 2: Title of Model or Diagram (16 pt)
