

Protocols in Place for Zapustas Arena

Updated: 1/27/2021 -

- **EVERYONE must wear a mask at all times, even on the ice.**
- **25 person maximum for spectators (still only one parent/guardian per youth per game, 0 spectators for practices, 0 spectators for adult programs).**
- **Families in the parking lot must also social distance and wear masks.**

General Protocols for All

- Only 1 parent spectator per player for Youth Program games
 - parent/guardian only to enter arena 5 minutes before game
 - parent/guardian must leave arena immediately after game
- No spectators allowed for Adult Programs or any age practices
- All those in arena must maintain proper distancing protocols
- All must wear masks in all areas including public bathrooms
- All must follow foot traffic and occupancy limit notices in all areas
- Bathrooms and all high traffic areas will be cleaned periodically
- Concessions are closed for now - vending machines are open but use at your own risk
- Skate sharpening will be available (credit card payments only); staff will sanitize hands before handling skates and transactions
- Hand sanitizer and/or soap will be available and offered throughout the building - please use them
- Maximum allowed number of people on ice at any one time is 50

Guidelines for Players *while off the ice*

- All players to dress at home as much as possible before coming to the arena as locker rooms are not available
- Benches are provided in open areas for available spaced-out seating for those unable to come fully dressed
- Locker rooms are not available, but benches have been set up in open areas for changing skates while maintaining social distance

- All players must arrive no more than 20 minutes before their skate and must leave within 15 minutes after getting off the ice
- All players must wear face coverings everywhere, including on the bench until going onto the ice
- Wearing a mask on the ice is recommended
- All team members must maintain social distancing between each other everywhere, including on the bench as much as possible
- Water bottles must be labeled with player's name to avoid cross contamination; no large coolers or shared beverages
- If a player, coach, referee or parent is feeling sick or has any symptoms, they must stay home
- Anyone with signs of sickness will be asked to leave immediately

Contact List Management

- Each player is to check off their name on lists provided by coach upon entering the building
- All coaches or program managers must provide a list of their players with contact info for each session/game/practice to use during check in at entrance
- All visitors (including spectators) must sign contact tracing sheet

Guidelines for Players, Coaches and Referees

while on the ice

PLAYERS

- All games will be "no-check." As governed by USA Hockey's "body contact" rules
- No handshakes allowed after the game
- Only 1 player allowed in penalty box at a time; if more than one penalty being served, subsequent players remain on the bench

COACHES

- Coaches are required to wear masks at all times - on and off the ice

REFEREES

- Referees must wear face coverings at all times - on and off the ice
- Whistles will be sounded via an electronic device

FOR ALL

- Maximum allowed number of people on ice at any one time is 50

Guidelines for Coaches/Parents/Referees

YOUTH HOCKEY PROGRAMS

- Spectators are limited to 1 parent/guardian per youth participant for games only, not practices
- All spectators must wear face coverings at all times
- All spectators must maintain social distancing while watching their child
- All players/parents/coaches must follow traffic flow signs and occupancy limit notices in all areas in the arena

ADULT HOCKEY PROGRAMS

- Spectators for adult programs are not allowed at this time
- All players/coaches must follow traffic flow signs and occupancy limit notices in all areas of the arena
