1. HOST AND ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

Day Sailer Association members of Northern and Southern California, including Fleets 4, 31, 56, 75, 97, 128 and all independent members.

2. RULES

This regatta will be governed by the 2025-2028 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of U.S. Sailing, the rules of the Day Sailer Association, and by the Sailing Instructions.

3. ELIGIBILITY

Current Day Sailer members, as defined by the Day Sailer Association, are eligible. All boats in the competition will be measured. Boats with a current measurement certificate will be honored.

The registration fee is \$375 before June 15th. Late registration after June 15th until July 14th at 12 noon will be \$425. Registration fee includes T-shirts for skipper and crew, welcome dinner, and two dinners for the awards banquet. Additional T-shirts and dinners are available on the regatta network website above.

5. VENUE & SAILING AREA

All races will be held at Huntington Lake in California. Huntington Lake is located at 7000 feet above sea level in the Sierra Nevada mountains 70 miles east of Fresno, CA.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- NACR Sailing instructions will be made available at registration with updates provided on Tuesday morning at the Skipper's meeting.
- Sailing Instructions for Junior NACR will be handed out Monday at the Junior NACR Skipper's meeting
- Courses for NACR and Junior NACR will not be the same.

8. BOAT STORAGE

Boats may be stored in the water or in the launch area parking lot.

9. SCORING

The low-point scoring system of Appendix A of the 2025 -2028 Racing Rules of Sailing will apply. Five or more races must be completed before a throw-out will be applied. Three races must be completed to constitute a Championship.

10. PRIZES

Take home trophies will be awarded to the top ten finishers in the Championship Fleet, the top five finishers in the Presidential Fleet, and perpetual trophies in categories as defined in the DSA Handbook. Trophies will be awarded at the awards banquet on Thursday, July 17th.

11. FURTHER INFORMATION

Access to Huntington Lake depends on water to fill the lake. We feel confident that there will be adequate water in Huntington to hold our championship. Still things may change so if you decide to secure accommodations be sure to secure a clear cancellation "by" date.
