

Breakout EDU/Escape Room Set-Up:

1. Watch this [video](#) to walk you through how to set up a Breakout EDU/Escape Room using Google Forms. Please email ssukow@d155.org if you have further questions!
2. Build your WebQuest or series of clues in the chart below.
3. Then create a new Google Form. (Make a copy of the [Google Form template](#))
4. Retitle your form.
5. In the description of the Google Form paste your instructions from this doc into the form. Instructions may read:
 - a. Welcome to your Breakout EDU Challenge! To progress through the process, you must answer a question correctly using ALL CAPS! Make sure you SHOUT your answer and spell it right. Otherwise, you will be prompted to "Try Again." Your first task is simply to write the word "READY" in all caps.
 - b. Good luck to you on your quest.
6. Make a new section for EACH question.
7. Change the response validation for each answer. Hint: Make your answers simple and in all caps. Make sure you type in the answer and the phrase "Try again" if the student submits the wrong answer.
 - a. Response validations can include text or numbers.
 - b. Response validations need to match the answer exactly.
8. Paste each question from your Google Doc into your Google Form. Adjust response validation accordingly.
9. In the last section, indicate to students that they are done. You can create a section that asks students to reflect and assess their learning.
