

04.26.22 SLT Meeting

Ms. Giamadakis called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm and indicated that Principal Paniagua is out today.

Participants included: Giamadakis, Kambourian, Chevy, Hyman, Jancu, Wyszinski, Kaminsky, Sawicki-Mallien, Mayer, Miale, Khan

Principal Update:

- Academic recovery program ended last week
- 2 parent workshops this month – yoga and ENL
- Congresswoman Meng visited the school yesterday.
- 86% of students took ELA exam.
- Tomorrow will be second day of math state exams
- Securing school assemblies including Harlem Magic Masters, Midori Music, author visit
- Ending years with assemblies, school events and reimagining the beginning of the next school year
- Landscaping fundraiser took place during earth week – earned \$1,400 to beautify school property
- DOE indicated that they will distribute additional home testing kits. Ms. Giamadakis is confirming inventory.
- Science tests for grade 4 (performance and written) begins May 24. Written assessment will take place in June and there will be two makeup dates.

PA Update:

- Upcoming events include Spring Fling/Auction (April 30); Fun Run (May 14); Movie Night (May 30); International Dinner (June 8) – attempting to do this outside, which allows for expansion; Magic Show and Sing Along; Book Fair
- General membership is tonight at 7pm; Nominating committee will be reading nominations and closing them
- Presenting new bylaws tonight, no significant changes – per Chancellor's regulations, review every 2 years and making minor adjustments.
- Afterschool program has helped bolster PA budget, putting the PA in a stronger position than recent years.
- Yearbooks and boosters are on sale now.

CEP Planning:

- Mr. Hyman gave an overview of the past 6 years of data, identifying patterns and factors that likely influenced progress (Envision math, TC)

- Collective data indicates steady results, hoping to continue building momentum as students are school more consistently this year.
- Students performed well despite obstacles faced. Additional insight will come when we see how they performed this year.
- SLT broke up into committees to review data, discuss and begin drafting 3 strong attainable CEP goals – ELA, Math, SEL
- Committees summarized their discussions and shared drafted goals, which will be the focus of the next SLT meeting.
- Related to the SEL discussion, Ms. Giamadakis introduced PBIS (Positive Behavior Incentive & Supports) pilot. She has connected with the PA to obtain prizes for good behavior. Action items for next year include a nomination/reward system, poster contest, etc.
