School Day

Uniform

Please can all items be clearly labelled!

Let's all strive to continue the standards of uniform. Please see the statement and reminder below from our school website:

We believe that the children should take pride in their appearance and always come to school looking smartly dressed in the correct uniform. All of the Cheselbourne uniforms are available to buy at Tesco's or in our second hand school uniform shop run by the CSF. We may also be able to provide help to any families who need support buying their child's uniform, if this is the case, please speak to Mrs Husher in the office.

Grey school trousers, skirt or pinafore - required

Black or Brown shoes with flat heels and nonslip soles (not trainers) Sensible school style black or brown boots can be worn in winter. - required

PH Sports will continue to provide our PE provision on both Monday and Friday.

PE will happen outside as much as possible, therefore jumpers and coats daily is essential.

- Monday PE = Caterpillar Class + Butterfly Class + Kingfisher class
- Friday PE = Butterfly Class + Kingfisher Class

Monday:

Year Reception, 1, 2, 3, and 4: Enter school in PE kit, stay in this kit all day, and return home in it. A school jumper is required for an additional warmth layer.

Friday:

Year 1, 2, 3, and 4: Enter school in PE kit, stay in this kit all day, and return home in it. A school jumper is required for an additional warmth layer.

Outdoor Learning clothing - required

All children from Preschool to Year 4 do Outdoor Learning each week (Thursday) so need old, long sleeved clothing and shoes to wear for this. In wet and cold weather they also need wellies, waterproof trousers and a warm waterproof coat, hat and gloves.

Hair & Jewellery

All hair should be neat & tidy for school. Long hair (for safety and hygiene) should be tied up please. For the safety of all children, the only jewellery allowed in school is a small stud earring. Children will be asked to remove these for PE lessons.

Changes in 2025:

 Staff: We welcome Miss Blair and Mrs Hughes to our team! Both will be working across our morning education plan and lunchtime. There will be flexibility across our team and how they will be deployed to best support your children. Miss Blair will mainly be supporting in Kingfisher Class and Mrs Hughes in Butterfly Class.
