Agenda

- Summarize progress and needs
 - we are going from 22 to 17 teachers next year
 - the district program has criteria for discontinuing DLI programs
 - Diamond Ridge is not at the point of discontinuing the french program
 - We reviewed the LAND trust plan proposed for 2024-2025 which suggests we use the LAND trust to pay for 3 aides - all voted in favor of this plan
- Collect data and monitor LAND trust funds
- School LAND Trust Plan, Reading Achievement Plan, and signature page due in MARCH
- Review staffing plan after receiving it, but before the staff plan due date. Pay close attention to surplus situations and be prepared to address questions and concerns
- Child Access Routing Plan (Safe Walking Route), using SNAP (Student Neighborhood Access Plan through UDOT, due to the District Traffic Safety Committee

 - We will need information to vote on LandTrust fund next month for the 2024-2025 school year

 - Sandra - 3D pens would be great for Maker Space and STEAM classes
 - Etching printers for wood, etc. for designing
- Marketing for the DLI French program
 - We have FTE discrepancies between french and english classes
 - Possibility: French teachers will still have their 2 classes, but the English teachers would share all the students for the English side
 - Parents of kids that have gone through the french program don't speak highly of it.
 - Kids don't like the french program in Junior High
 - It takes up their electives
 - Kids are not passing AP tests
