<ul> <li>Require staff and students to stay home when sick or if they have been in close contact with</li> </ul>			
someone with COVID-19 within the past 14 days. Parents/guardians, students and staff should			
notify school administrators of illness and known exposure.			
Have a policy for daily symptom screening for students and staff; have plans for students and staff			
to report symptoms that develop during the day.			
In conjunction with local health department, identify COVID-19 rapid testing resources (viral			
testing) for when staff and students develop COVID-19 compatible symptoms.			
Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces at least daily.			
Ensure adequate hand hygiene supplies are readily available.			
Implement physical distancing measures (e.g., reducing occupancy (staggered schedules, use of
