

## **Core Practice Professional Development Spotlight**

engagement practices that integrate family voices and goals in the schooling process

Estimated time needed: 20-30 minutes

## Resources:

<u>Slides</u> (Make a copy for yourself, and adapt them for your school)

- 1. **Introduce/Review of Core Practice**: Use the homepage of this <u>website</u> or the slides to introduce/review what this core practice is.
- 2. Whip around Activity: Ask staff to share one way they have used this core practice already or an idea they would like to try.
- 3. **Examples**: Share some examples from ED 593 class (see <u>ED 593 Core Practice H Examples Folder</u> or use your own).
- 4. **Short hands-on activity ideas:** Jigsaw in small groups to discuss the 5 Family Engagement Goals.
  - Divide staff into 5 groups. Try to mix veteran teachers, new teachers, and parapros for this activity. Pass out <u>Family</u> Engagement Goal Cards, or refer to Slide 4.
    - o Directions:
      - As a group, read the assigned Family Engagement goal and share ideas for how you could meet this goal as a teacher. What does this look like in your classroom? How have you seen this done in your colleagues' classrooms? Brainstorm 3-5 strategies. Write your group's ideas down and be ready to share with the whole group!
- 5. **Next Step Protocol:** Close the PD session with a protocol that helps staff identify their next step using this core practice. Adapting the following activity might work well by skipping the 4th step if needed: 1-2-All or choose your own protocol.
