Meet Malala Yousafzai

Malala Yousafzai is 23 years old and she is an activist for girls' education. She is from Pakistan but now lives in Birmingham, England. Here's why she is famous:

It is October 9th, 2012. Malala is 15 years old. She wakes up early, has breakfast and goes to school. She studies a lot because she wants to be a doctor. After school she takes the bus home with her friends, as usual.

The bus stops. A man with a gun¹ gets on the bus and... "Bang!" because some people do not want girls to study! Malala needs help! They take Malala to hospital and soon she is strong again! When she returns home, she tells her family and friends:

"Education is important for everybody, not only for men. Women must have the same access to information. Education can help millions of poor people around the world".

Malala is an inspiration for young people, including many artists. Her message to kids is:

"Always do what is right. When you fall, you must always stand up".

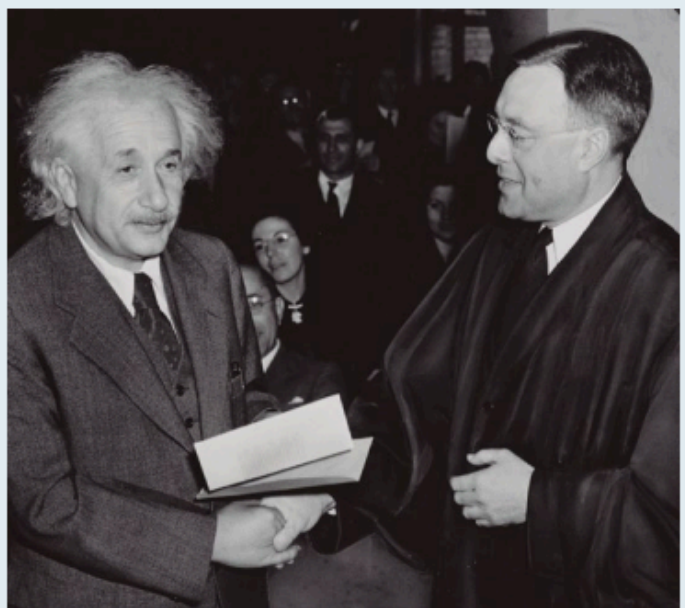
Remember Malala Yousafzai and her fight for education? Another person to admire is Albert Einstein. A true fighter, too!
