## **APA Format**

We have crunched some numbers and now need to write up a narrative. This is an exercise in formal writing using APA formatting specifically text,tables, and references citations.

\*\*Pay attention: you must pick any two (2) research questions and report their findings. It would probably be easier to have 1 table for so 1 DV i.e browser, teaching/not teaching, gender I have emailed you a document that contains formatting to help you.

Create a document in <u>APA</u> format that summarizes your recent activity which are equivalent to the "Methodology" and "Results" Discussion sections of a research paper based upon your data analysis.

Your **Methodology** section will parallel the example in that you must

Describe the research questions

Describe the data collection, sample, and survey.

Describe the data analysis

Clearly using this as a guide you will not include the Measures section because you have no information about the survey.

Your **Findings** section will include text answers to your question. You must also create a table to display your findings, specifically the means and standard deviations for your study.

Your Reference section should include any references you have. You MUST have at least 2 references

You have probably used online references to determine APA formatting (Chart, Tables, Numeration, Format).
