• Education Committee: WSD Staff

- Committee report-SHANNON
- Shannon joins via Zoom. She says that she and Piper and Shauna will take turns coming to meetings and giving the Education Committee report.

- Shannon says thank you to Ashley and Taylor for getting the PSO going and congratulates them on their Learn Here Clark County awards.
- She mentions that communication needs to be improved, she has been developing a communication plan for the last year or so and is still learning about Parent Square. If any parents have feedback about Parent Square, please let Shannon know.
- Shannon asks if parents would like to continue to receive information in video form, and parents say yes they would like that.
- 2-3 years ago through the accreditation process admin gathered information about WSD and she would like to do that again. They will use a survey to gather information from parents and incorporate that feedback over the next few years. Shannon wants our ideas and feedback on what questions to ask in the survey.
- Shannon emphasizes that information related to campus safety is very important and also making sure that students feel involved in the learning process here.
- Shannon asks if parents have received the WSD newsletter and some people said they have not received any. They only come out 3 or 4 times a year. The most recent one was on the School Improvement Plan (SIP). Currently the school is focused on ASL, written communication, and Social and Emotional Learning, specifically focused on students who are neurodiverse. The third goal is to focus on attendance, but that is already going well so far this year.
- To give feedback to Shannon, parents can email or maybe admin will set up a focus group in person. Stephanie says she can help brainstorm ideas for that and that social media can help a lot, that could be a good avenue for communication. It's not necessarily the job of PSO to communicate all school info but PSO can support WSD like sharing announcements etc.
- Josie says that she would like all parents to know about both elementary and secondary events and other info because if you have younger children you can have some idea as to what to expect when your child moves up to the other levels.
- Parents would like to have more announcements in ASL and not just English and Spanish. Not sure who would be responsible for that but hopefully in the future we could do something like that. Shannon mentions that bigger schools have a Communications Coordinator but WSD is too small to have that specific position. But we can continue to try to figure out how to improve communication here regardless. Ashley mentions that Shannon Eagen-Andersen would probably want to help with that and she could maybe work with Stephanie on that.
- The new building is looking nice and starting to feel more comfortable every day with additions of plants and accessories.
- Belle mentions that she still has not found the 9 hidden bricks in the new building. The bricks say the word "Hidden" on them, because that is the name of the company who manufactured them. Those bricks are special because they are from the old Red Barn building.

• Questions/Comments/Member-led New Business:

- SURPRISE GIFT FROM PSO TO LOGO WINNER! Belle gives a specially designed shirt to Stephanie for designing the winning logo for PSO
- Recruiting for the Holiday Party Committee- Ashley says PSO is taking over the holiday party this year instead of the residential staff. Ashley has put in a grant request to DEAF for \$1000 for the holiday party. There will be a signing Santa, Kelly Johnson (Belle's husband) and each child from the elementary school will receive a gift. Please volunteer for this event committee if you can! We don't have a date yet for the party but it tends to be at the end of the school day like 1:30-3. But last year PSO also came in the early morning for the preschoolers. This year the party will probably be during the first week of December.
- O Josie says she would like to have a class picture taken this year because for the last few years there was no class picture. Stephanie says you can contact the yearbook committee which might be Teresa Stotler. Shannon says Rima tends to coordinate the photography so she can ask RIma about that. Shayne Blayloch took the pictures last year at All Star Day last year. Stephaine says that some parents have opted out of having their children photographed so they might need to be contacted for this specific photo, otherwise we could have those kids just not in the pictures. Josie adds that the photos will not be posted anywhere but they are just for kids to keep, so maybe we can just send home a form for parents to sign just for that photo.
- Marely brings up STEAM- for K-12. We don't have a program like that here at WSD. Ashley says
 DEAF is trying to raise money to have a STEAM lab right now. RIght now there is no computer
 lab at WSD. Marely says she would like to see WSD hire teachers for STEAM classes
- Shannon says there will be teachers using that lab for a variety of things like computer programming, coding, E-sports. Marely would like to see classes in engineering, robotics, etc.
- Stephaine mentions that a lot of parents don't even know what WSD offers here to the students
- Shannon says there is a plan to design a lab in the storage area behind the cafeteria. Right now
 they are just gathering information and consulting with people who know what would be
 required for that. Hopefully can be ready for next academic year.
- Ashley says she will meet with DEAF soon to see how PSO can support the STEAM lab
- Ashley mentions that as a staff person she has access to a lot more information than parents and probably parents would like to know about sporting events scores, etc. Stephanie would like to have all that info available for parents on social media
- Seven Star asks what to do with leftover brochures? Belle suggests putting them around the school- Rima has a display in the office for brochures

- Marely says maybe kids want to help make food to sell or sell candy bars- not sure if other schools are still doing those kinds of fundraisers. Ashley mentions that schools used to have prizes for selling a certain amount of things and that could be fun.
- Ashley says Marely cna go ahead and start working on a fundraiser selling something, the fundraising committee needs to get together and plan and organize that.
