Dear Families,

As we near the end of the 2021-2022 academic school year, ODE and the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) are partnering to expand at-home COVID-19 testing for all children in Oregon’s public K-12 schools. OHA is providing free, at-home [iHealth COVID-19 tests](#) for the Beaverton School District to distribute to our student population. Each student will receive one test kit, containing 2 tests, to take home. This distribution represents one strategy to increase access to testing resources in our school communities.

Students and families are encouraged to use the test kit for symptoms consistent with COVID-19 or who have had a known exposure to COVID-19 . If your student tests positive or experiences two of the following primary COVID-19 symptoms, they must stay home for 5 days from the onset of symptoms unless documentation of a negative COVID-19 test is provided.

- Fever of 100.4°F or higher
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
- Chills

Please be aware that muscle aches, headache, sore throat, diarrhea, nausea, vomiting, new nasal congestion and runny nose are also symptoms often associated with COVID-19.
