Course Title: Technical Theatre II

Course Purpose: Technical Theatre II builds upon the skills learned in Technical Theater I as they relate to the backstage world of theatre. Students will learn theatre terminology as well as the basics of technical theatre in the areas of sound, makeup, props, and costuming. As part of the course, students will be applying their new skills by working on the technical elements of the plays and musicals. Due to this being a hands-on class, good attendance is essential to doing well.

Course Outcomes

Outcome/Unit 1	Students will identify and analyze elements of costume design
Outcome/Unit 2	Students will create original costume designs based on given character information
Outcome/Unit 3	Students will individually design, pattern, and create a costume piece
Outcome/Unit 4	Students will learn the process of props design
Outcome/Unit 5	Students will design and create a prop and document the process
Outcome/Unit 6	Students will learn the process of makeup design and basic techniques for theatrical makeup application
Outcome/Unit 7	Students will identify the components of a sound system and their functions
Outcome/Unit 8	Students will design and create their own sound effects
Outcome/Unit 9	Students will apply knowledge learned in one or more of the following areas: set construction, scenic painting, theatrical lighting, costume construction, sound design- to create something for use in a stage production.
