## **❖ LWVCO Actions**

- ☐ LAC Determined Actions on State Bills
- ☐ Action Alerts to Members Individually, to act on State Immigration Issues
  - With form letter and talking points
  - Asking members, individually, to contact state officials *with approval of Action & Advocacy leadership*
- ☐ Combatting Misinformation and Disinformation, Individually and as LWVCO
  - Letters to Editor - *template to Beth before distribution*
  - Social media
  - Supply state officials with facts if they make unsupported statements
  - Joint News Access and Literacy/J.E.D.I. Task Force Meeting on Immigration if News Task Force agrees
  - *Partner with NAL Task Force*
- ☐ Education -
  - J.E.D.I. Task Force Meetings
  - Partner Programs
  - Resource Folders
    - ◆ Fact checked
    - ◆ Credible sources
- ☐ Partner with and assist immigrants' rights' organizations
- ☐ Document ICE Actions Using ACLU Mobile Justice App

- If approved at time by LWVCO, notify members of actions after egregious ICE and executive actions on deportations; help mobilize demonstrations, etc -
- *LWVCO needs LWVUS coordination*

## ❖ **Local League Actions**

- Ask Local Leagues to Consider Advocating on Immigration Issues Locally
  - If they agree, Appoint Local Liaisons to J.E.D.I. Task Force
  - If Help is Requested, we will assist with:
    - ◆ Action Alerts for members, individually, to contact local officials
    - ◆ Help Combat Misinformation and Disinformation locally *in partnership with NAL Task Force*
    - ◆ Distribute information to immigrants in communities on immigrants' rights vetted by partner organizations
    - ◆ Education
    - ◆ For members, individually, partnering with immigration protection groups if approved as partners

## ● **National Actions with LWVUS Permission**

- Ask LWVUS for permission to lobby for detention center accountability and inspections
- Possible advocating for 2025 version of 2024 Bi-Partisan Bill sponsored by Jason Crow
