Absences & Make-Up Work Policy:

Students are responsible for completing all work missed when absent from school.

Upon returning to school, the student or parent must arrange with the teacher to secure the student make-up work. Students must complete all work missed in a time frame that is equal to the days absent from school.

If the absence is excused, the student has three days from the date of return to complete the work. Late work - Tests and projects are 20 points off each day late.
