[Black Women's Health Imperative](#) – BWHI is the first and only national non-profit solely dedicated to achieving health equity for Black women in America.

[Indigenous Women Rising](#) – Reproductive justice for Indigenous uterus owners in North America and Canada

[Support Ya Sistah at The Afiya](#) – Black-led reproductive justice organization that supports the lives, health, and overall wellbeing of Black wxmen in Texas. It's the only reproductive justice organization in North Texas founded and directed by Black women

[SisterSong](#) – SisterSong's mission is to strengthen and amplify the collective voices of indigenous women and women of color to achieve reproductive justice by eradicating reproductive oppression and securing human rights.

[SPARK](#) – SPARK envisions a world free from economic, social, political, cultural and sexual oppression – especially anti-Black oppression; where Black queer women and young people, including trans folx and folx living outside the gender binary have access to rest and thrive.

Queer-Led Organizations

[National LGBTQ Task Force](#) – LGBTQ people need access to reproductive health care, including contraception, abortion, assisted reproductive services, HIV care, pregnancy care, parenting resources, and more. Although many people talk about reproductive health as a “women's issue,” many LGBTQ people—including lesbian and bisexual women, transgender men, two-spirit, intersex, nonbinary and gender non-conforming individuals—can get pregnant, use birth control, have abortions, carry pregnancies, and become parents.

Other Organizations

[Planned Parenthood](#) – Many of Planned Parenthood's patients are people who have historically faced barriers to quality health care. Often, those patients are people of color, people who live in rural areas, LGBTQ people, people with low incomes, and people without health insurance. Without Planned Parenthood health centers, many of these patients may have no other place to turn to access safe and legal abortion — or preventive care like birth control, annual exams, and lifesaving cancer and STD screenings.

[The Brigid Alliance](#) – This organization books, coordinates and pays for travel, travel

expenses, and child care, serving as a single, trusted point of contact for every step of the journey wherever someone needs to get to abortion care in the U.S.

[AidAccess](#) – Aid Access supports women, girls, trans men, nonbinary and all people with an unwanted pregnancy to access an abortion or miscarriage treatment. If you are healthy and less than 10 weeks pregnant.
