Getting to Know You Bracelet

Materials Needed:

- A pipe cleaner for each student
- An assortment of beads (pink, blue, green, white, orange, yellow, purple, red, blue)
- Small clear tubs (enough for 1-2 for each table)
 - I like using clear tubs because it is easier for the students to see the different colors of beads. I have used Ziplock storage containers.

Set-Up:

- Place bags of pipe cleaners on the middle of each group of desks.
- You can place a clear container filled halfway with beads in the middle of each group of desks.

Directions:

1. Please grab one pipe cleaner and set it on your desk.
2. Please read the bead chart one color at a time. Slide a bead on your pipe cleaner if the color shows who you are.
3. When you have added all of your beads, wrap the pipe cleaner around your wrist and twist the ends together.
4. Complete the math bead worksheet.

The chart below tells you what each color bead means. Read the chart carefully and choose your beads. Have fun! ☺

Bead Color	What it Means	
Pink	You are a girl	
Blue	You are a boy	
Green	1 bead for every brother	
Yellow	1 bead for every sister	
Orange	1 bead for every pet	
Red	0=no music 2=rock music	1=Country music 3=Classical music
White	0=like dogs 2=like snakes	1=like cats 3=like horses
Purple	1 bead if you are excited to start school this year!
