

## Mascoutah High School 2024 Summer School Program Information May 31 - June 28 Session 1 - 7:30 a.m. - 10:30 a.m.

<u>Summer School Registration</u>: Registration begins **Tuesday, January 16th** for all current MHS students. Incoming 9th grade registration, will begin on **Monday, February 5th**. Registration will remain open until all classes are full.

Classes Hours: Summer School hours are from: 7:30a.m. - 10:30 a.m.

Absences & Tardies: Students are expected to be in attendance everyday.

- Students must attend all 22 days.
- An absence will result in being dropped from the class with a failing grade of a F.
- Tardies:
  - Students who arrive up to 15 minutes after class has started will receive a tardy. (3 tardies = 1/2 day absence)
  - Students who arrive more than 15 minutes after class has started will be charged a 1/2 day absence.
  - Students arriving 1 hour and 30 minutes after class starts will be charged a full day's absence.

Accommodations: There will be NO accommodations offered during summer school for students with an IEP or 504.

<u>Grades:</u> Summer school will be cumulative for all twenty-two days. There will be no progress reports or a final exam. Parents and students are encouraged to look at the Skyward Portal daily. Report cards will be available in Skyward once grades are finalized.

Transportation: Transportation is NOT provided for Summer School Classes.

<u>Behavior</u>: School policy is in effect during summer school. Misconduct from any student may remove you from the summer school class. (Refer to handbook - available online)

Refunds/Cancellation: Cancellations need to be made by May 1, 2024 in order to receive a full refund. Any cancellation requests after this day will need approval from MHS Administration.

## How to Register -

- Complete the registration form on the back and return to MHS Student Services with cash or check payment. All checks should be made to MHS. Class slots will only be held when payment is received.
- 2. Students may enroll in one or two classes. If we are unable to meet your request, you will be notified.
- Please make sure your student will not be attending any extracurricular camps during the session times before signing up because in person attendance is mandatory.
- ALL classes will be IN PERSON.

## **Driver Education Class: (In-Person Only)**

## (Maximum 28 spots available)

Students may register if they are 15 by April 1, 2024 and earned four credits in the two previous semesters. Students must register by **Friday**, **February 9th** to be considered for this class. Acceptance is given to the oldest **28 students**, of those who register before the deadline. Should capacity not be met by February 9, we will continue to accept signups.

Cost: \$200 to MHS at registration - 0.3 credit

\$20 to Secretary of State after passing permit exam

Time: 7:30 am - 9:30 am

<u>Driving will be in-person and may exceed scheduled</u> summer school days.

Sports/Aquatic P.E: (In-Person Only)

(40 students maximum) All activities include swimming, fitness, canoeing, bowling, soccer, softball, tennis, volleyball, kickball, archery, & walking. All fees for activities are included.
