Subject	Supplies Needed
Crew <i>*All 10th graders take this course!</i>	☐ Crew journal (notebook/journal for Crew only!) ☐ Homework Planner
English <i>*All 10th graders take this course!</i>	☐ 1-inch binder ☐ Loose leaf paper ☐ Many packs of post-its (6-8 packs recommended) ☐ Highlighter ☐ Pens and Pencils!
Global History <i>*All 10th graders take this course!</i>	☐ 2-inch binder , for Global History <u>only</u> <i>*You need a large binder for this class! A 1-inch binder will not be large enough to hold all your papers for the year. You will be able to leave this in the classroom!</i>
10th Grade Math (Algebra I or II) <i>*All 10th graders take this course!</i>	☐ At least a 2 inch binder (Algebra I) or spiral notebook (Algebra II) ☐ Folder (specifically for Math) ☐ Pencils ☐ Pens ☐ Graphing Calculator - TI84 or higher <i>*OPTIONAL - one will be provided if the student does not have one*</i> ☐ Hand Sanitizer to donate to the classroom
Physical Education <i>*All 10th graders take this course!</i>	☐ Sport shorts or sport pants ☐ T-shirt (non-MELS shirt) ☐ Sneakers ☐ Lock for gym locker
French	☐ 1 inch binder ☐ 4 dividers ☐ Pencils ☐ Looseleaf paper ☐ OPTIONAL: flashcards to study vocab
Spanish	☐ 1-inch binder ☐ Lots of looseleaf ☐ Lots of pens and pencils

Visual Art	☐ Several #2 pencils (not mechanical) ☐ Hand-held pencil sharpener ☐ Block erasers (pink, gum, plastic or otherwise) ☐ 1-2 inch, 3-ring binder ☐ Binder dividers (4-5) <i>* No loose-leaf paper necessary.</i>
Instrumental Music/Health	☐ 1 Folder ☐ Pencils (no pens!)
Chemistry	☐ One composition notebook or binder with paper for Chemistry <u>only</u> (you may need two, one for each semester) - can be left in the classroom ☐ One folder for labs and other assignments that are being brought home ☐ A calculator (optional)
Earth Science	☐ Tape (2) ☐ 1 composition graph notebook (with graph paper) ☐ 2 composition notebooks ☐ Highlighters ☐ Binder dividers ☐ Markers ☐ Ruler
