- Instruct students to choose a reading material and read silently or with a partner during the DEAR session, focusing on identifying and reading CVC words.
- 2. CVC Word Hunt (60 minutes):
 - After the DEAR session, organize a CVC word hunt activity where students search for CVC words in the reading materials.

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		 Provide students with a list of CVC words to find or encourage them to identify CVC words independently. As students find CVC words, have them write the words down or circle them in the text.
Post-reading	30 minutes	 Word Sorting Activity (15 minutes): Provide students with a set of CVC word cards or pictures. Instruct students to sort the word cards into categories based on their vowel sounds (e.g., words with "a," "e," "i," "o," and "u" sounds). Word Bingo Game (15 minutes): Play a game of CVC word bingo with the students, using a bingo card with CVC words randomly placed in the squares. Call out CVC words, and students mark the words on their bingo cards. The first student to get a line of marked words shouts "bingo" and wins the game.




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
