

## ACADEME-INDUSTRY COOPERATION AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Academe-Industry Cooperation Agreement (henceforth, the “Agreement”) is entered into by and between:

The **UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES LOS BAÑOS**, a constituent university of the **UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES**, the national university of the Philippines, created by virtue of Act No. 1870, as amended and re-organized and operating by virtue of PD 58 and RA 9500, with office address at College, Laguna, Philippines represented herein by its Chancellor, **JOSE V. CAMACHO JR.**, hereinafter referred to as “**UPLB**”

The UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES LOS BAÑOS, and \_\_\_\_\_, recognizing the benefits to both parties of the establishment of industry-academe linkage, conclude this agreement.

1. The purpose of this Agreement is to develop academic and educational cooperation and promote mutual understanding between the two Parties;
2. Both Parties share a common vision and goal of improving the training and skills of students by putting his/her technical knowledge of \_\_\_\_\_ into practice; acquire a working knowledge of the technical and human aspects of \_\_\_\_\_; learn new knowledge and techniques and gain experience from the farm/field operation as well as contribute toward the company’s improvement;
3. Both Parties agree to develop the following collaborative activities on the basis of equality and reciprocity:

Industry-Academe Linkage Areas of Collaboration

- a. On-the-Job Training (OJT)/Practicum/ Internships – Private companies and government agencies will host at least 240 hours of practicum/OJT/internships;
  - b. Job Placement – Job fairs, roadshow and career talks organized by UPLB’s \_\_\_\_\_ (College Name) (henceforth “xxxx”) will give \_\_\_\_\_ (Corporation’s Name) the opportunity to be exposed to future hires and give career options to graduating students and alumni;
  - c. Joint Research Programs – \_\_\_\_\_ (College Name) faculty, staff and students will conduct research to address private industries’ issues, problems. \_\_\_\_\_ (Corporation’s Name) may share their facilities and/or give financial support for the conduct of the research;
  - d. Training Programs/Seminars – \_\_\_\_\_ (College Name) may conduct technical training programs for \_\_\_\_\_ (Corporation’s Name) employees. \_\_\_\_\_ (Corporation’s Name) technical experts will be invited regularly to share with \_\_\_\_\_ (College Name) students their knowledge of the latest types of products/technology produced in the industry;
  - e. Involvement in the design and revision of the curriculum - \_\_\_\_\_ (Corporation’s Name) will be invited to be part of the \_\_\_\_\_ (College Name) Program Advisory Council (PAC) to advise the college on such matters as: program relevance; advancement of new technology and innovations and their inclusion in the curriculum;
  - f. Adopt-a-room/laboratory – \_\_\_\_\_ (College Name) envisions renovation of some of the existing classroom/laboratories and acquiring the fixtures and laboratory equipment and tools through financial assistance of \_\_\_\_\_ (Corporation’s Name);
  - g. Adopt-a-student/Scholarship Programs – The Adopt-a-student Program is a financial assistance program conceived for low-income students of \_\_\_\_\_ (College Name) and will be administered by the \_\_\_\_\_ (College Name) Alumni Association; and
  - h. Adopt \_\_\_\_\_ (College Name) Technology – \_\_\_\_\_ (Corporation’s Name) may adopt technologies developed by \_\_\_\_\_ (College Name) subject to the existing Technology Transfer Laws and Intellectual Property Rights.
4. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this Agreement will be separately negotiated and agreed upon between the Parties who will carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective parties after full consultation and approval.

5. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of cooperation stated in clause 3 may be restricted depending upon the availability of resources and financial support of the Party concerned.
6. All collaborative activities and exchanges under this Agreement shall not be conducted or enforced unless a separate specific activity agreement is executed between the Parties herein observing the same formalities and all limitations specified herein.
7. Nothing shall diminish the full autonomy of either Party nor will any constraints be imposed by either upon the other in carrying out this Agreement or in any subsequent specific activity agreement.
8. This Agreement may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both parties.
9. Within thirty (30) days from the effectivity of this Agreement, each Party shall inform the other Party in writing the name of its staff/office who/which will serve as its liaison officer/office with the other Party under this Agreement.
10. This Agreement is valid for a period of three (3) years from the date of signing by the representatives of both Parties. This Agreement may be renewed subject to the review and renegotiation by both Parties. Such review and negotiation shall be conducted within sixty (60) days prior to the expiration of this Agreement.
11. This Agreement may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by any one of the Parties, upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than six (6) months before the termination date.
