(<https://boettcherfoundation.org/scholarship-application/>). **Please encourage students to start working on their application as soon as possible in order to meet the student application deadline of November 1 at 5 p.m.** Please note that the application review is a holistic selection process that evaluates applicants on **all four** of our selection criteria (superior scholastic ability and intellectual curiosity; evidence of leadership and involvement; service to community and school; and outstanding character).

## Mental Health Tools & Community Resources:

- *Free Therapy for Colorado Youth:* I Matter provides up to six free therapy sessions for any Colorado youth 18 and younger, or 21 and younger who are receiving special education services. This Mental Health Awareness Month, support mental health wellness for youth, and visit [IMatterColorado.org](http://IMatterColorado.org) to sign up for in-person or telehealth services in English, or [YoImportoColorado.org](http://YoImportoColorado.org) for services in Spanish. Youth 12 and older can sign up for services without parent or guardian consent. Youth 11 and younger can have their parent or guardian sign them up.
- *The Gary Bamford Pack Pantry* at Bamford Elementary is now open and has a variety of winter clothes and coats sizes toddler to adult. The pantry will be available to the public 4 more times this year. No documentation or paperwork is required to visit. Dates are 4/29 9:00-11:00AM and 5/9 3:00-5:00PM.
