When we let our students know what happens, where, and when, we reduce uncertainty and anxiety and ensure our students feel safe as they explore the magic of dance.

Want to follow along on the fun times at home?

Try calling out a different body part and then counting along with your child as they tap that body part 8 times. It's a great little activity that can bring some joy to a long, boring car trip or add a little musicality to some downtime at the park. You can even pop on some of your favourite songs at home or in the car and give it a go. Ask questions like "which songs do we have to tap slower to?" and "Which ones make us we tap faster?"

It's all part of the carefully considered planning that goes into making sure your child's dance experiences are positive, stress-free and filled with memorable moments that will last them a lifetime.

So, how does learning pantomime in a dance classes help our little ones in life?

- 💫 greater awareness of emotions and needs in themselves and others
- Note: The practice expressing our needs and wants, especially when finding the right words can be hard
- Name in the properties and confident communication in the properties and confident communication.
- improved interpersonal skills, including picking up on social cues which are crucial to developing relationships

So while our lessons may be getting a little dramatic \$ and a little silly ② we know that there's a whole lot of good going on behind the scenes, and we wouldn't have it any other way!
