

YOUTH SUMMER TEMPLE AND FAMILY HISTORY CLASS

A Temple and Family History Class for younger youth will be held at the Omaha FamilySearch Center on June 1-5! Please see the details below:

- **When is the class?** Classes will be held Monday through Friday, June 1-5. The classes will be held in the morning and will be 1 hour and 15 minutes in length. Exact times will be determined based on the number of registrants and classes needed.
- **Who is invited to attend?** Young men and young women turning 12 or 13 in 2026 (birth years 2014 and 2013) are invited to attend the class. See Q&A below.
- **What will be covered?** This is a class for beginners and will include instruction and activities in the areas of FamilySearch navigation and use, writing journals and personal histories, research basics, preparing for temple work, and ways to be involved in family history this summer and beyond!
- **Where will class be held?** The class will be held at the Omaha FamilySearch Center which is located on the north side of the Stake Center.
- **How can I register?** Click [REGISTRATION](#). Parents are encouraged to help their youth through the registration form.
- **Prerequisites:** Participants need a FamilySearch account and need to know or bring their login and password! Youth are able to create accounts with parental permission. Parents, please assist your youth with account setup. See Q&A below.

- **Do class participants need a FamilySearch account?**
Yes, a FamilySearch account is needed to effectively participate in class learning and activities.
- **How old do I need to be to create an account?**
Anyone over 13 years of age can create an account. With parental permission, children ages 8-12 can create accounts.
- **How do youth create a FamilySearch account?**
Read and follow instructions at [create a free FamilySearch account](#) (age 13+) or [create a free account for a child](#) (age 11-12).
- **Do I need my church membership information to create an account?**
To enable Church features, Church of Jesus Christ membership information is required. Parents can see the membership number of their children in the Tools app. If needed, contact your Ward Clerk or a member of your bishopric to obtain membership information.
- **Do I need a laptop or cell phone?**
No. Participants will use computers at the FamilySearch Center.

- **What do I need to bring to class?**

Participants need to know or bring their FamilySearch account login and password. Please bring a notebook (any size) and a pencil.

- **How many youth can participate?**

Based on instructor availability, up to three classes of 8 participants each will be held.

- **Can I bring a friend?**

Yes, friends are welcome. Please note that some activities will be focused preparing for temple service (e.g., finding and printing names). Friends can observe and help a member or participate in an alternate activity at that time.

- **Can older youth participate in the class?**

The Temple and Family History class is being planned for younger youth while older youth are encouraged to attend youth conference. This opportunity is not intended to compete with participation in youth conference for the older youth.
