- ☐ **Two Pair** Comfortable shoes (you will be walking a lot)
- ☐ Jacket & windbreaker (weather in DC will be in the 60s. We might have a little sprinkling of rain, so something you can tie around your waste is preferred)
- ☐ Sunglasses
- ☐ Sunblock
- ☐ Poncho or small umbrella, or rain jack with hood
- ☐ (optional) hat
- ☐ (optional) prescription glasses, contacts, solution...etc

Toiletries

- ☐ deodorant
- ☐ brush
- ☐ toothbrush/toothpaste
- ☐ facewash
- ☐ (girls) feminine hygiene products, shampoo/conditioner, makeup, razor, elastic bands

- ☐ wallet (Not recommended to bring your entire wallet, just what you need. Please use your travel neck wallet)

- ☐ small backpack/fanny pack (2 strap backpacks are not allowed in most museums in DC. One strap bags, purses or a draw-string small backpack are usually fine)
- ☐ water bottle (There are museums that do not allow water bottles and you will be informed what days those will be)
- ☐ (optional) any medications or prescriptions
- ☐ (recommended) snacks like granola bars, fruit snacks, gum (we only have time to stop for designated meals, so if you get hungry often, please be prepared)

*****Carry on** liquid items (lotions, liquid makeup, sunscreen, toothpaste, water bottle) have to be smaller than 3 ounces AND have to be in a sealed bag. When in doubt, it is best to just check it in
