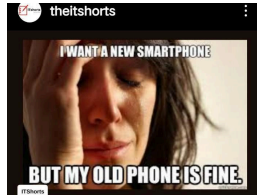




### Meta's new AI thinks Mark Zuckerberg is creepy and manipulative
