City Park

- Barnes and Butterfly Garden planting, mulching, and weeding
- Finish trimming grass along walkway to south Wildfire meadow down by wildflower meadow and Purple Martin poles
- Finish cleanup of south shore on Lake and haul debris to Public Works dumpster

HGB I

- The HGB I trail needs cutting back of overgrown vegetation as well as many dead cedars from the February freeze.
- Recent rains have resulted numerous erosion ruts in HGB I that need to be filled. Lances crew had done a lot of repair, only to have it taken out by heavy rains last week.

HGB II

- Dar and Carl had cut down several cedars near picnic table and water fountain last winter and placed them to the side of the trail They are still laying off to side of trail and should be removed. LTFR said they will eventually get to it, but are short staffed. FOP could haul it out to chipper or let LTFR eventually get it out.
- There is a lot of erosion on Squires trail and needs a load of crushed granite hauled in to repair washouts.
