Sonic the Hedgehog (1991)	In this fast-paced platformer, players control the blue hedgehog, Sonic, as he races through various worlds collecting rings and battling the evil Dr. Eggman. This game is a classic example of a young hero on a quest, which is a common theme in media aimed at teenagers.

Indiana Jones and the Dial of Destiny (2022)	Archaeologist Indiana Jones races against time to retrieve a legendary artifact that can change the course of history.
Indiana Jones and the Kingdom of the Crystal Skull (2008)	In 1957, Indiana Jones becomes entangled in a Soviet plot to uncover the secret behind mysterious artifacts known as the Crystal Skulls.
Indiana Jones and the last crusade (1989)	In 1938, after his father goes missing while pursuing the Holy Grail, Indiana Jones finds himself up against the Nazis again to stop them from obtaining its powers
Indiana Jones and the temple of doom (1984)	In 1935, Indiana Jones is tasked by Indian villagers with reclaiming a rock stolen from them by a secret cult beneath the catacombs of an ancient palace.
Raiders of the Lost Ark (1981)	In 1936, archaeologist and adventurer Indiana Jones is hired by the U.S. government to find the Ark of the Covenant before the Nazis can obtain its awesome powers
Pirates of the Caribbean: The Curse of the Black Pearl (2003)	Blacksmith Will Turner teams up with eccentric pirate "Captain" Jack Sparrow to save his love, the governor's daughter, from Jack's former pirate allies, who are now undead
Pirates of the Caribbean: Dead Man's Chest (2005)	Jack Sparrow races to recover the heart of Davy Jones to avoid enslaving his soul to Jones' service, as other friends and foes seek the heart for their own agenda as well.
Pirates of the Caribbean: The World's End (2007)	Captain Barbossa, Will Turner and Elizabeth Swann must sail off the edge of the map, navigate treachery and betrayal, find Jack Sparrow, and make their final alliances for one last decisive battle

Pirates of the Caribbean On Stranger Tides (2010)	Jack Sparrow and Barbossa embark on a quest to find the elusive fountain of youth, only to discover that Blackbeard and his daughter are after it too.
Pirates of the Caribbean: Salazar's Revenge (2017)	Captain Jack Sparrow is pursued by old rival Captain Salazar and a crew of deadly ghosts who have escaped from the Devil's Triangle. They're determined to kill every pirate at sea...notably Jack
Jurassic Park	A pragmatic paleontologist touring an almost complete theme

(1993)	park on an island in Central America is tasked with protecting a couple of kids after a power failure causes the park's cloned dinosaurs to run loose
The Lost World: Jurassic Park (1997)	A research team is sent to the Jurassic Park Site B island to study the dinosaurs there, while an InGen team approaches with another agenda.
Jurassic Park III (2001)	A decidedly odd couple with ulterior motives convince Dr. Grant to go to Isla Sorna for a holiday, but their unexpected landing startles the island's new inhabitants.
Jurassic World (2015)	A new theme park, built on the original site of Jurassic Park, creates a genetically modified hybrid dinosaur, the Indominus Rex, which escapes containment and goes on a killing spree

Jurassic World Fallen Kingdom (2018) Jurassic World: Dominion (2022) The Lord of the Rings trilogy (2001-2003)	When the island's dormant volcano begins roaring to life, Owen and Claire mount a campaign to rescue the remaining dinosaurs from this extinction-level event Four years after the destruction of Isla Nublar, Biosyn operatives attempt to track down Maisie Lockwood, while Dr Ellie Sattler investigates a genetically engineered swarm of giant insects Set in the fictional world of Middle-earth, the films follow the hobbit Frodo Baggins as he and the Fellowship embark on a quest to destroy the One Ring, to ensure the destruction of its maker, the Dark Lord Sauron. The Fellowship eventually splits up and Frodo continues the quest with his loyal companion Sam and the treacherous Gollum. Meanwhile, Aragorn, heir in exile to the throne of Gondor, along with the elf Legolas, the dwarf Gimli, Merry, Pippin, and the wizard Gandalf, unite to save the Free Peoples of Middle-earth from the forces of Sauron and rally them in the War of the Ring to aid Frodo by distracting Sauron's attention.
Wonder Woman (2017)	Before she was Wonder Woman, she was Diana, princess of the Amazons, trained to be an unconquerable warrior. Raised on a sheltered island paradise, Diana meets an American pilot who tells her about the massive conflict that's raging in the outside world. Convinced that she can stop the threat, Diana leaves her home for the first time. Fighting alongside men in a war to end all wars, she finally discovers her full powers and true destiny
Fast and Furious franchise (2001-present)	Fast & Furious (also known as The Fast and the Furious) is a media franchise centered on a series of action films that are largely concerned with street racing, heists, spies, and family.

The Mandalorian (2019-present)	The travels of a lone bounty hunter in the outer reaches of the galaxy, far from the authority of the New Republic
Jumanji: Welcome to the Jungle (2017)	Four teenagers are sucked into a magical video game, and the only way they can escape is to work together to finish the game.

Dungeon and Dragons: Honour among thieves (2023)	A charming thief and a band of unlikely adventurers embark on an epic quest to retrieve a lost relic, but things go dangerously awry when they run afoul of the wrong people.
The Golden Compass (2007)	In a parallel universe, young Lyra Belacqua journeys to the far North to save her best friend and other kidnapped children from terrible experiments by a mysterious organization
Night at the Museum (2006)	A newly recruited night security guard at the Museum of Natural History discovers that an ancient curse causes the animals and exhibits on display to come to life and wreak havoc.
Merlin (2008-2012)	These are the brand new adventures of Merlin, the legendary sorcerer as a young man, when he was just a servant to young Prince Arthur on the royal court of Camelot, who has soon become his best friend, and turned Arthur into a great king and a legend.
His Dark Materials (2019-2022)	A young girl is destined to liberate her world from the grip of the Magisterium which represses people's ties to magic and their animal spirits known as daemons
StarDust (2007)	In a countryside town bordering on a magical land, a young man makes a promise to his beloved that he'll retrieve a fallen star by venturing into the magical realm
Maze Runner Trilogy (2014-2018)	The story follows sixteen-year-old Thomas, who awakens in a rusty elevator with no memory of who he is, only to learn that he has been delivered to the middle of an intricate maze, along with many other boys, who have been trying to find their way out of the ever-changing labyrinth – all while establishing a functioning society in what they call the Glade. They must try to find a way out.
The Hunger Games (2012)	The Hunger Games is a movie about a teenage girl, Katniss, who is selected to compete in a televised battle to the death. The movie addresses themes of survival, courage, and standing up against oppression, which are relevant for many teenagers.
Harry Potter (2001-2011)	A movie franchise based on the books by J.K. Rowling. The films follow the adventures of a young wizard named Harry as

	he navigates adolescence, learns about friendship, and battles evil.
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
