VTuber Quick Start Guide:

If you aren't super sure about diving in headfirst, try using a PNG to stream first! You can use <u>Discord Reactive Images</u> to set up a PNG that dims/lights up when you talk. Download OBS and try a few test streams to see how it feels before you go all-in!
You may want to commission a design first before finding a model artist. It's also quite common to ask your model artist to design you as well, but be prepared for added design costs.
Find a model artist to commission! If you don't already have someone in mind, try searching "Live2D commissions" on Twitter or simply posting on Discord servers or your own Twitter to see who's available
Find a rigger! In some cases artists already have riggers they really like to work with and might recommend you to someone. You can also try searching "live2d rig commission" on Twitter.
Once your model is ready, install tracking software! Almost everyone I know uses VTube Studio now. Ideally you'll want an iOS device (iphone, ipad etc) for face tracking for hardware reasons. If not, you can use webcam tracking or your Android camera too.
Panels, overlays, and other graphics aren't that important when you're just starting out, but here's <u>Ying's guide to doing them cheaply on Google Slides</u> .
