

2025 High School Winter Concert



Dear High School Band members and parents,

Our winter concert is scheduled for Monday, December 15th at 7:00.

This event is sure to get you in the holiday spirit. The HS band and choir students have been preparing their music for the past several weeks and it has been a great transition from marching to concert band. This is a great opportunity for you to hear both of the high school concert bands. The 9/10 “Black” band will start the concert followed by the 11/12 “Gold” band. We will have an intermission for our set change and the choirs will close things out for the night!

The 9/10 band will perform an initial warm-up and tune at 6:30. Please be in your concert dress and ready to go by this time. The 11/12 band will need to be dressed and in the auditorium to watch the 9/10 concert by 6:55 (if space allows). 11/12 will leave the auditorium before the 9/10’s final selection. 11/12 warm-up and tuning will be on stage. When the 9/10 band finishes performing they will exit the stage and find a seat in the auditorium to watch the 11/12 portion of the concert. We will have a 10 minute intermission after the 11/12 band to switch setups from band to choir. Please stick around to watch the choir after the 11/12 band.

Do not play your instruments in the hallways, they can be heard in the auditorium. The only time that you will play your horns before the performance is as a group during the designated warm-up times in the HS band room.

Dress: Guys: All men should be dressed in their black concert tux jackets, black pants, black dress shoes, socks and **red bow ties**. Girls: Wear concert dresses, **red sashes** and a comfortable black dress shoe. ***(All red sashes and bow ties will be handed out by band parents in the uniform closet.)*** Heels are acceptable if you have experience walking in them ☺. Hair should be worn back, behind the ears and no jewelry should be seen. We are creating a professional look for our audience so please look your best! Dresses and pants must be hemmed if newly purchased so if you still have not picked yours up please do so ASAP!

Please make sure that you have paid for your concert attire before the concert. Please make all payments out to the Glenwood Band Parents and take those payments to the HS office ASAP. Students who do not have the proper clothing attire will not perform.

There is an admission charge of \$3.00 for adults and \$2.00 for children 5 and up. Please let your family know about this fee ahead of time to avoid any embarrassing situations. All proceeds are split between the high school band and choir activity accounts and are used to offset audition costs, pay for awards and for travel and hotel rooms throughout the year. This is a family event so please invite your entire family!
