TC's Random Movie Pick

Star Trek II; The Wrath of Khan - 1982

The best Star Trek movie, by a long shot; though make sure you watch the extended director's cut for all the full scenes. Back before over-done CGI, in the days when a movie had a plot as opposed to non-stop action, Gene Roddenberry was still alive, and Star Trek was still more Sci-Fi than mindless action (*cough cough* Abrams films). This was the second motion picture for Star Trek, and one that was jaw-dropping on so many fronts. First, it was a damn good story. It follows the crew of the original Enterprise as they are asked to investigate an issue that was, initially, thought to be minor. In doing so, Captain Kirk and crew come face to face with an old foe from many years past - Khan. First encountered in the original series in the episode "Space Seed", Khan wants revenge for how Kirk left him. It is an amazing adventure of facing your fears, accepting epic loss, and being able to continue on.

Besides the plot, why was it so amazing? It took risks. I don't want to too much away, but they took a huge risk in the end with something they did to a very beloved main character. It provided what is considered one of the top 10 most heartfelt moments in movie history. You really felt for the crew and characters throughout this movie - especially if you had known them since the original series.

The Special Effects were ground-breaking - by far the very best of the era. In fact, [here's a battle scene from when the Enterprise \(staffed only with trainees outside the main bridge crew\) encounters the captured Reliant](#). This was 1982 - that was all done manually with optical effects, and it looks incredible. There were no CGI "sets" - they built all the sets, so it actually looks SO much more real when stuff is happening on the sets because it *is* happening on the set. People don't have to imagine it.

CGI - I know this sounds odd to say as amazing, but again.... this is 1982. This movie was the first movie to feature a CGI sequence depicting how the Genesis device functioned - [shown in this video](#). It was done by Industrial Light and Magic. No one had ever seen anything like that before. And CGI was used elsewhere too - the vector models of the ship on the bridge, various bridge and system displays and the star-field generations for when the ship was moving through space. Again... 1982! This took months and months of rendering work by the best computers of the day to pull off.

Music - arghhhf... the music for the original Star Trek movies was so, SO well done. Composed by James Horner, it was as epic and moving as the visuals and emotional moments, and continues to be heard in Star Trek productions to this day.

This film represented the very height of special effects, smoothly and perfectly balanced with good story-telling, action, music and emotional investment. It is one of my favourite movies of all time, and likely always will be. :)

Light-BDSM = Light bondage type play picture such as basic restraints or shibari

BDSM = more intense bondage, discipline, control, dominance, etc.

human = picture showing a human - in red to stand out for those who don't like human pics!

"a thing". *smiles* Scent that is a natural result of body chemistry and.... well, time is something that can be quite an alluring quality of a handsome foot. I know lots of folks, myself included, that enjoy that. And I'd say there are equal measures of those that either don't like it, or who like even more dirty/nasty stuff. While I don't quite get the latter, I can't really knock them for enjoying it - to each their own! You should meet Greer some time if you want a good lesson in the fine details of scent. *chuckles* I imagine though this is something you have to make sure a potential partner understands?

(AI) I'm glad you understand. Speaking of such thing... I really like it myself, just as you described. (AI) So your main thing is also worshipping, so to say... and ha! you are one lucky bastard then! You have more options to choose from!

(TC) I suppose so, hurr. I would enjoy being able to share my feet with someone who also felt the same because to see them and hear them enjoying them and knowing how the feel would hold a lot of emotional relevance too. Did you have any other questions?

(AI) *Smiles* Not at the moment, thanks for answering that! But please continue, you can throw many more questions at me if you'd like! ^^

(TC) Heh, alright. You have quite the adorable personality - with a partner that enjoys your unique (and potent) feet, do they enjoy just sometimes giving them a massage or having them on their lap while you watch a movie?

(AI) Th-thank you *Blushes slightly* I would guess so. The only one who does that is my own human... I particularly enjoy it with him as a way of... dunno... it's like a sick "guilty pleasure" of mine maybe? Like he's the culprit of my feet being the way they are, so he's gotta face the consequences of his actions! *Points to his head as he says the following* See? You gotta think before you do stuff, there are always consequences! So I like want him to suffer from this... sometimes he does -or he pretends to do so- so I get happy... but sometimes he enjoys it... but... I also get happy! *grabs his hair with both hands* Aaah! Am I saying I like it when he suffers but also when he's enjoying it? - Wait! I... Hold on! I don't want anybody to think that I like making others suffer with my feet -it's only him- But yeah... huh... if you're like a very close friend and want to do what you just described, I would enjoy it... if the friend enjoys it too... otherwise I'd be very uncomfortable. *stares with worried eyes* Sorry am I making a mess of this answer?

(TC) Hurr - no no, I think I get exactly what you mean. With Greer, one might say that getting to partake in his big snakey feet is both the most amazing and most torturous experience you could ever want as someone who enjoys scent, I think because there is always a part of the brain that goes "UGH!", even though slightly more of it is going "Mmm...." - if that makes any sense. :P To me, that sounds like the perfect fun sorta balance. :) So.... curious question then - do you ever go all the way enjoying your own feet?
